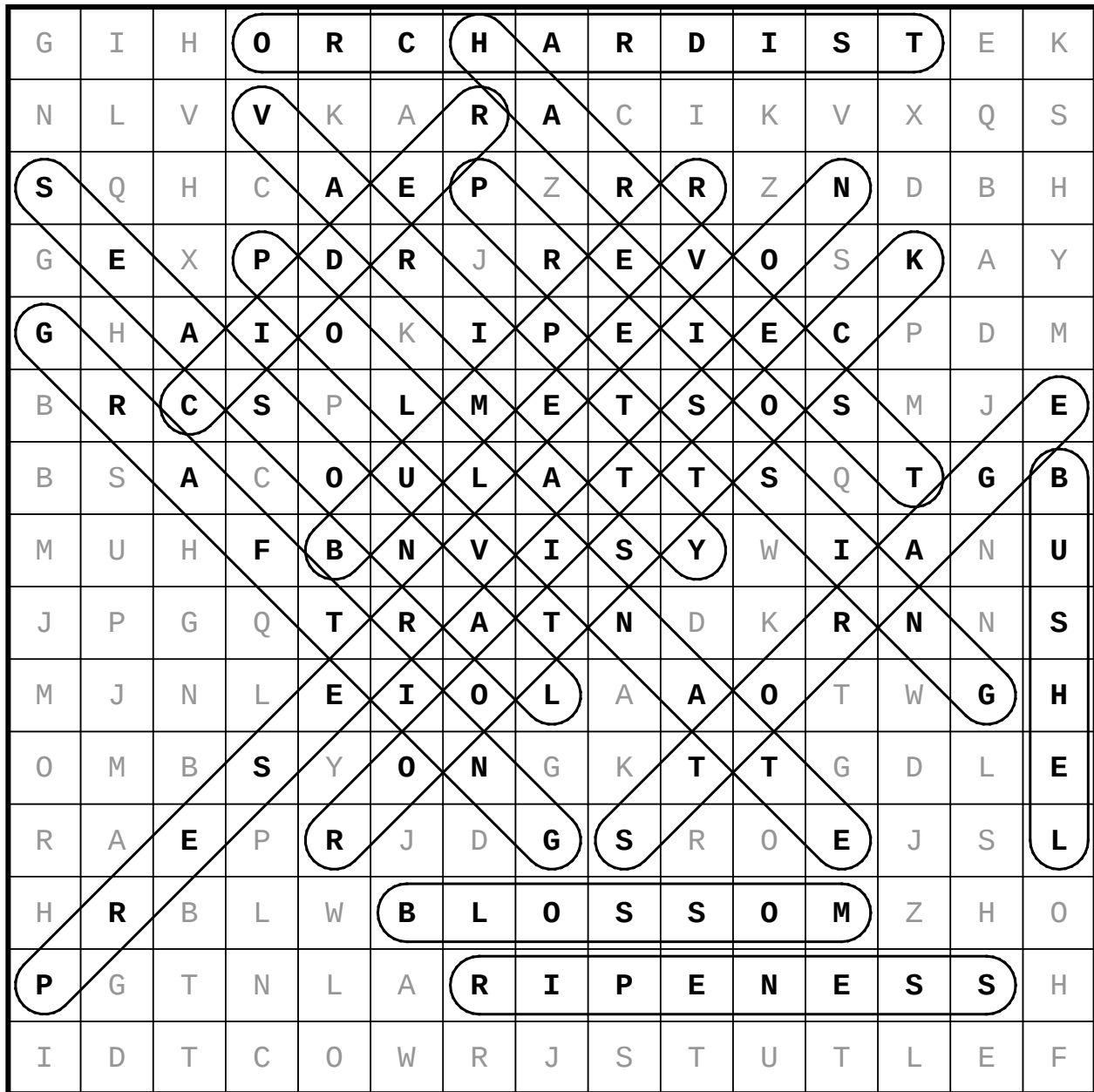

Apple Harvest — Answer Key



Did you know?

- Most apple varieties cannot pollinate themselves; orchards typically plant two or more different varieties together so bees can cross-pollinate them.
- Apple trees grown from seed rarely produce fruit like their parent, which is why orchards graft a specific variety onto rootstock instead.
- The science of growing fruit, including apples, has its own name: pomology.
- Some apple varieties can be stored for many months in cold, controlled conditions, which is how apples stay available well beyond the fall harvest.
