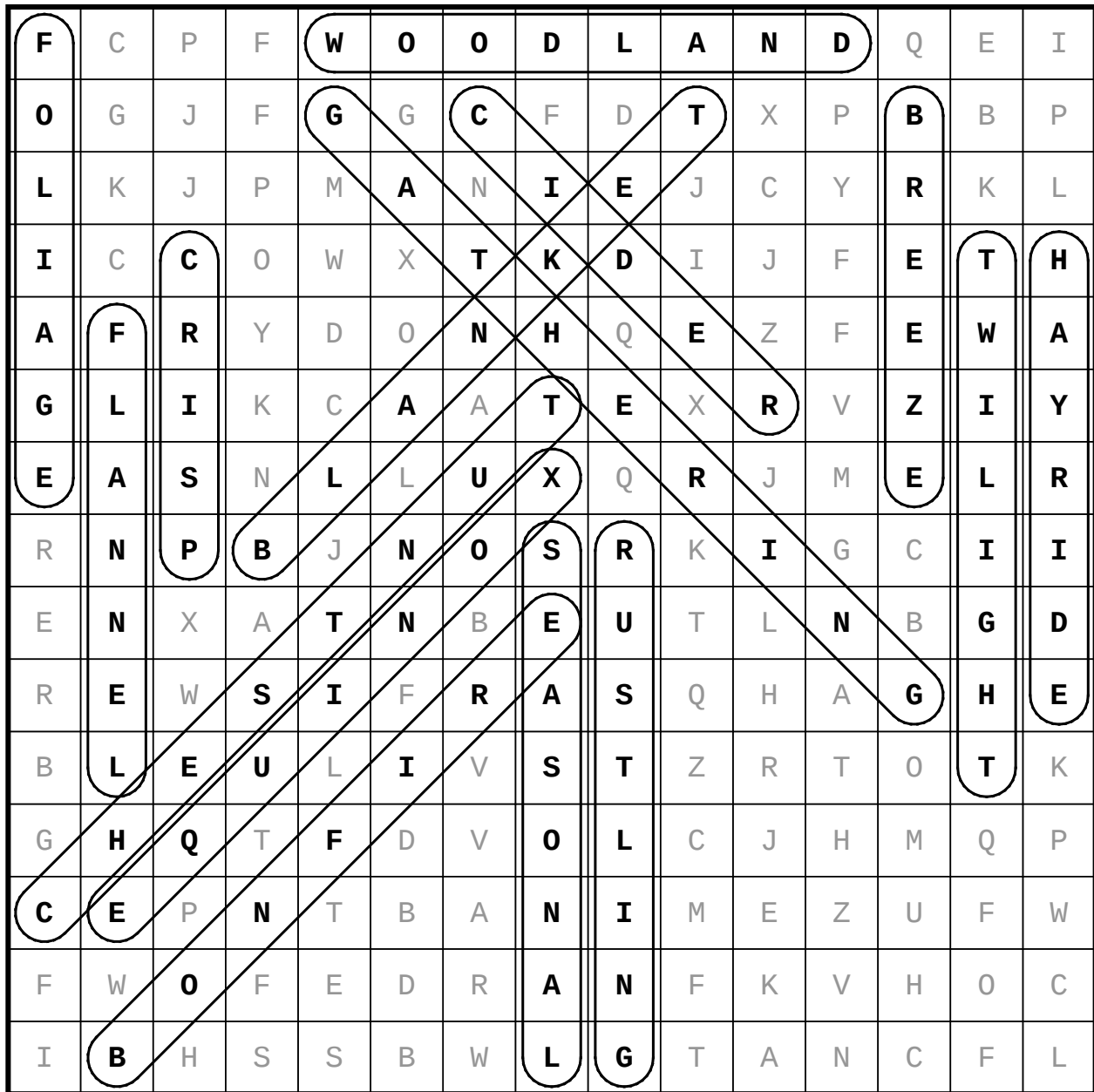

# Autumn Vocabulary — Answer Key



## Did you know?

- Meteorologists and astronomers actually define the start of autumn differently: meteorological fall always begins on September 1, while astronomical fall begins with the equinox, around September 22.
- The word "autumn" has been used in English since at least the 1300s, while "fall" is the newer, originally British term that later became the standard word in American English.
- A Harvest Moon is simply the full moon that falls closest to the autumn equinox, not a different type of moon.
- In the Southern Hemisphere, autumn happens in March through May, the opposite months from the Northern Hemisphere.

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
