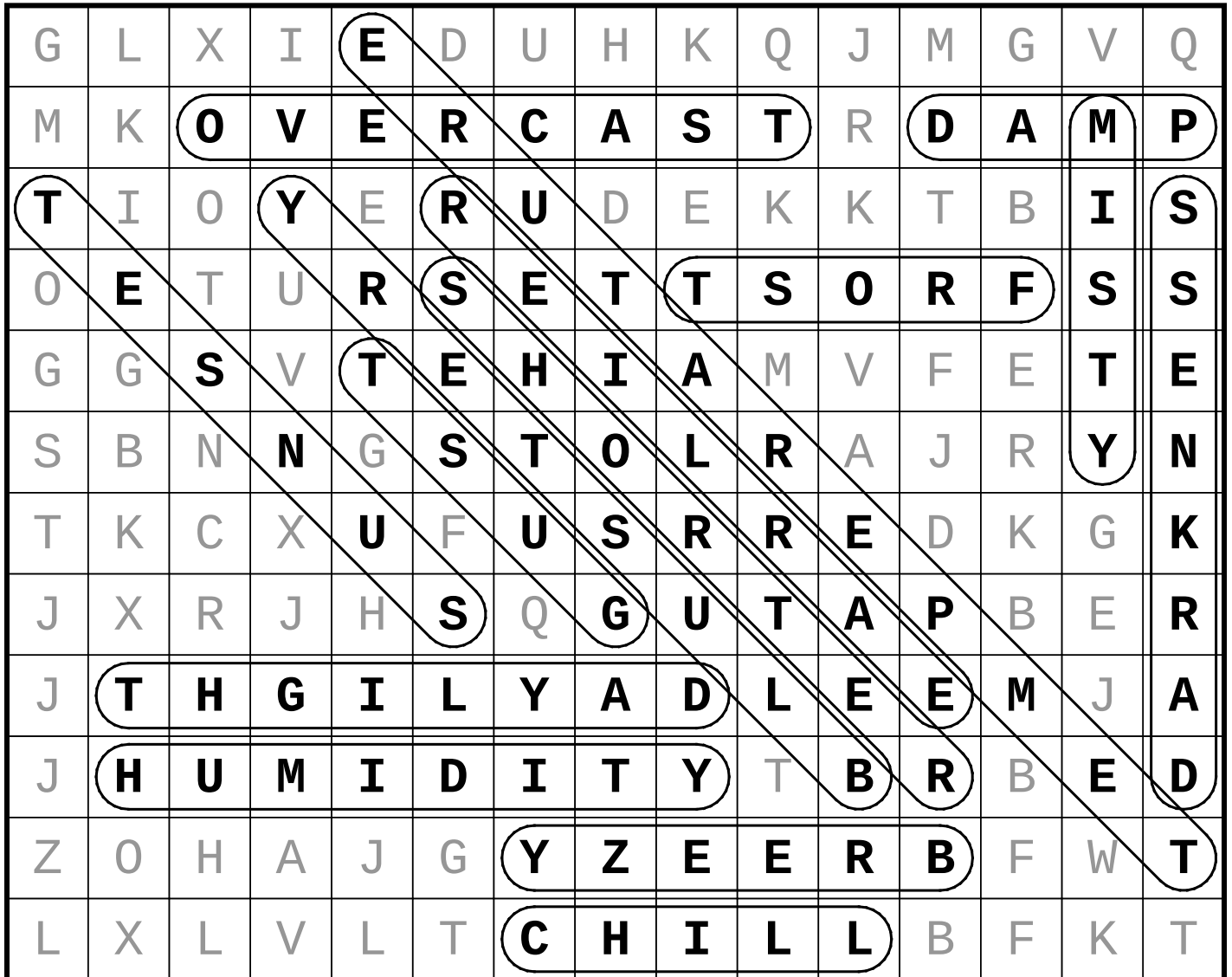

Did you know?

- Meteorologists define fall as running from September 1 through November 30, a fixed three-month period distinct from the astronomical equinox-to-solstice definition.
- The first frost date varies enormously by region and is tracked closely by farmers and gardeners, since it marks the real end of the growing season.
- Days genuinely get shorter throughout autumn because of Earth's axial tilt, not because of any change in how fast the planet rotates.
- Fog is more common on cool autumn mornings partly because cooler air holds less moisture, causing water vapor to condense closer to the ground.

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
