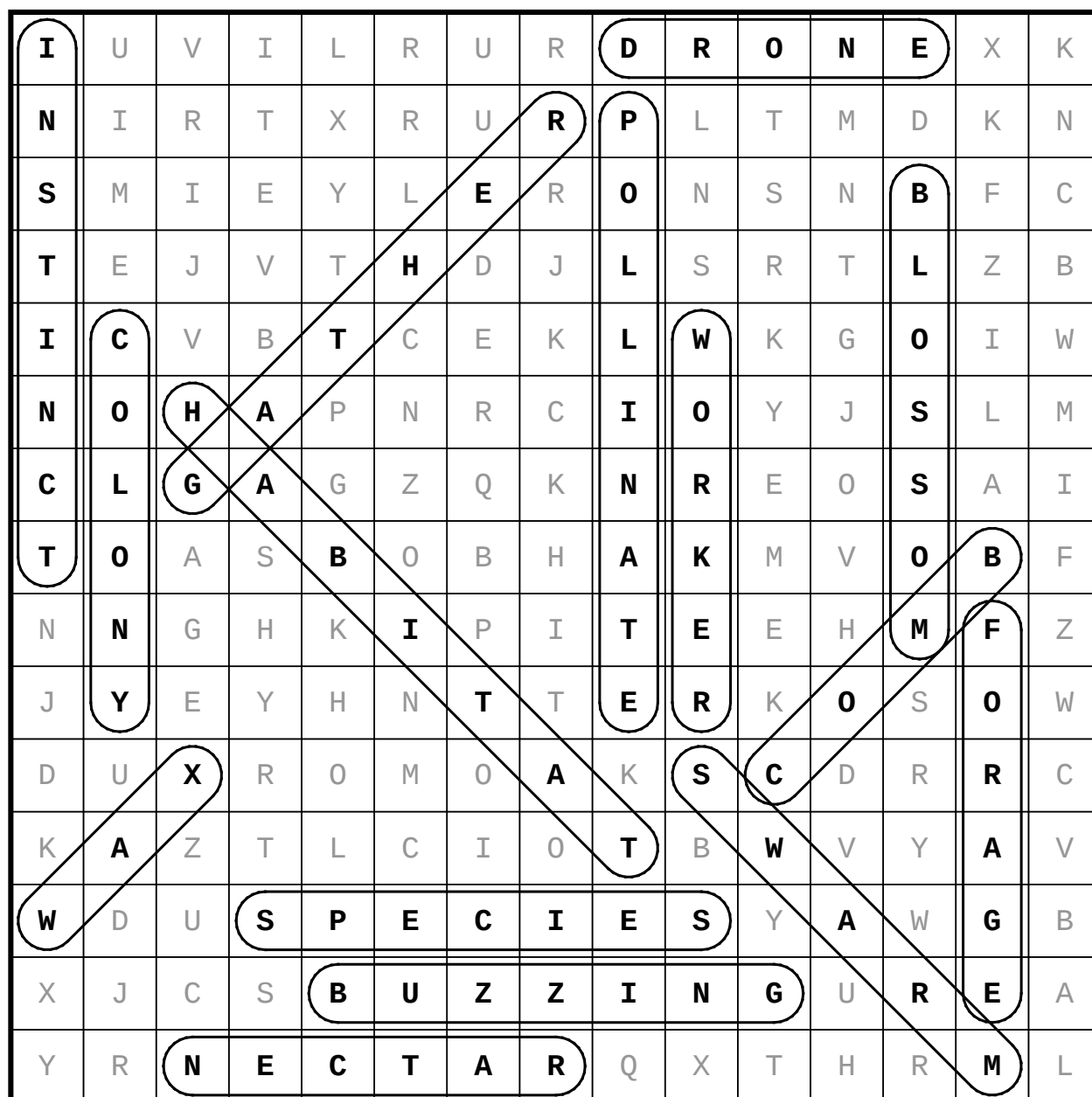

Bees — Answer Key



Did you know?

- Bees communicate the location of good flowers to each other through a specific movement pattern known as the waggle dance.
- Only female worker bees can sting; male bees, called drones, do not have stingers at all.
- Honey found in ancient Egyptian tombs has reportedly still been edible thousands of years later, since properly sealed honey rarely spoils.
- A single bee typically visits many flowers of the same species in one trip, which is part of why they are such effective pollinators.

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
