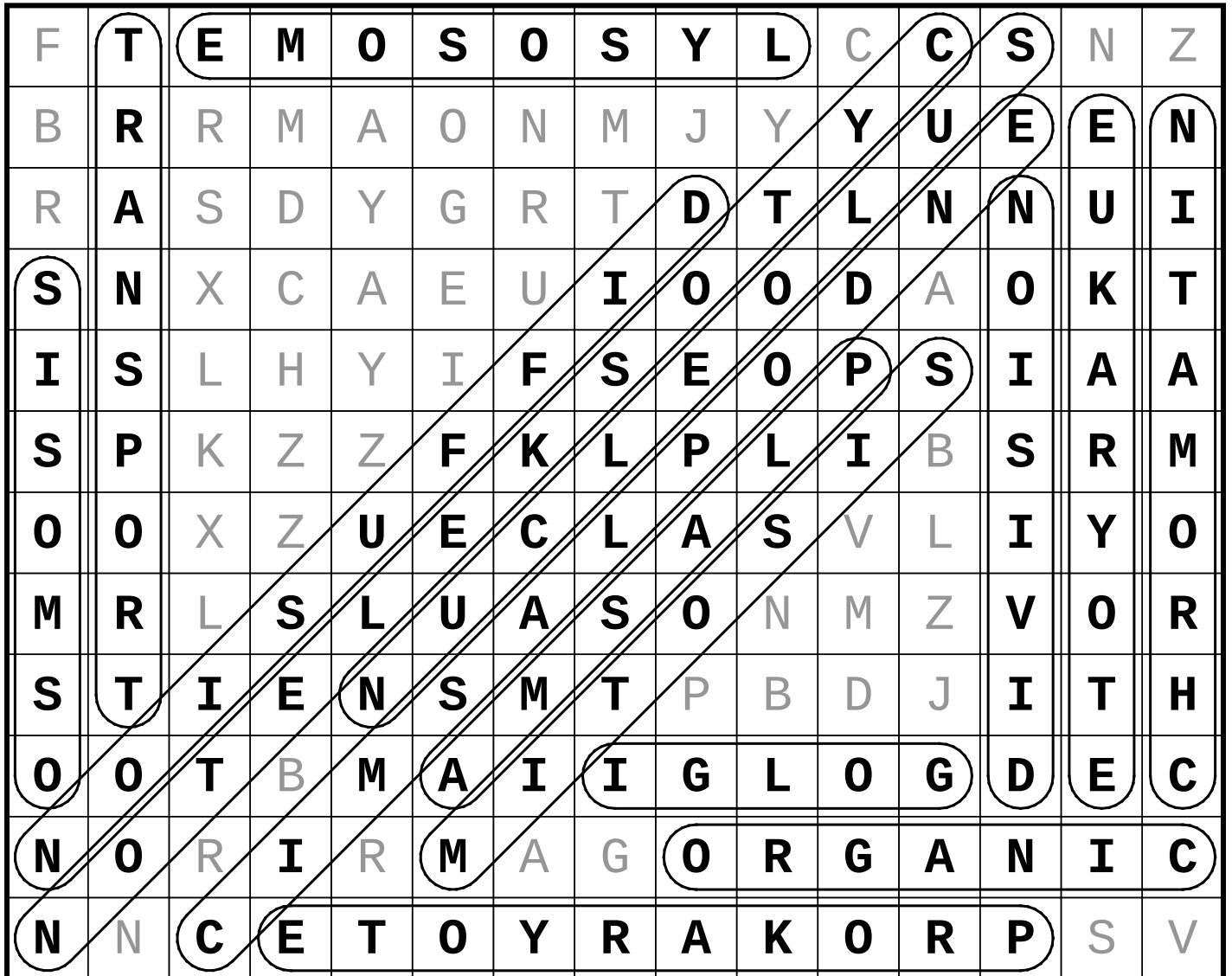

Did you know?

- The human body contains trillions of cells, each specialized for a particular job.
- Most cells are far too small to see without a microscope, though some, like certain egg cells, are visible to the naked eye.
- Mitochondria, found inside most cells, are often called the cell's powerhouse because they generate most of its usable energy.
- Some organisms, like bacteria, consist of just a single cell and can still carry out all the functions needed to survive.

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
