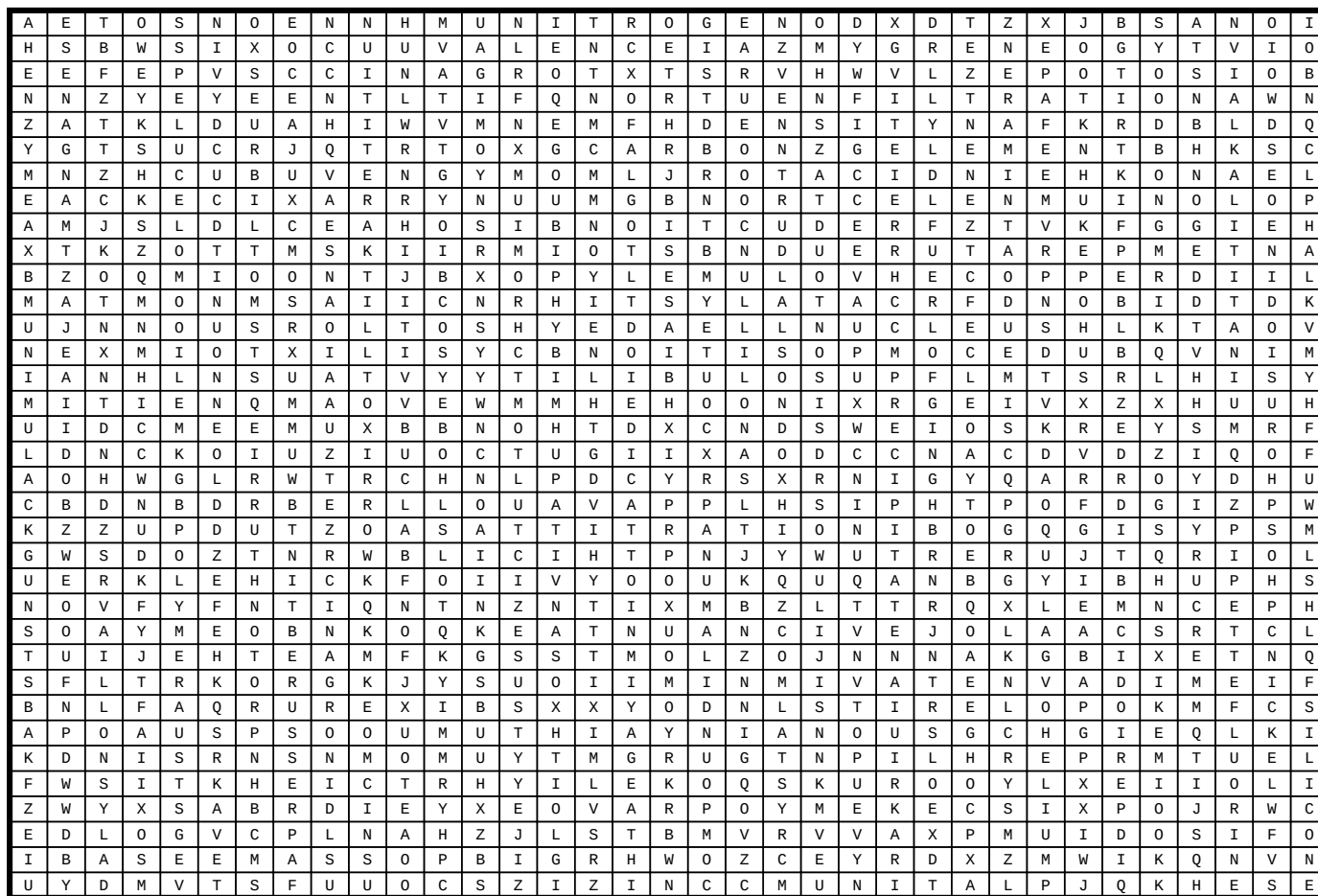


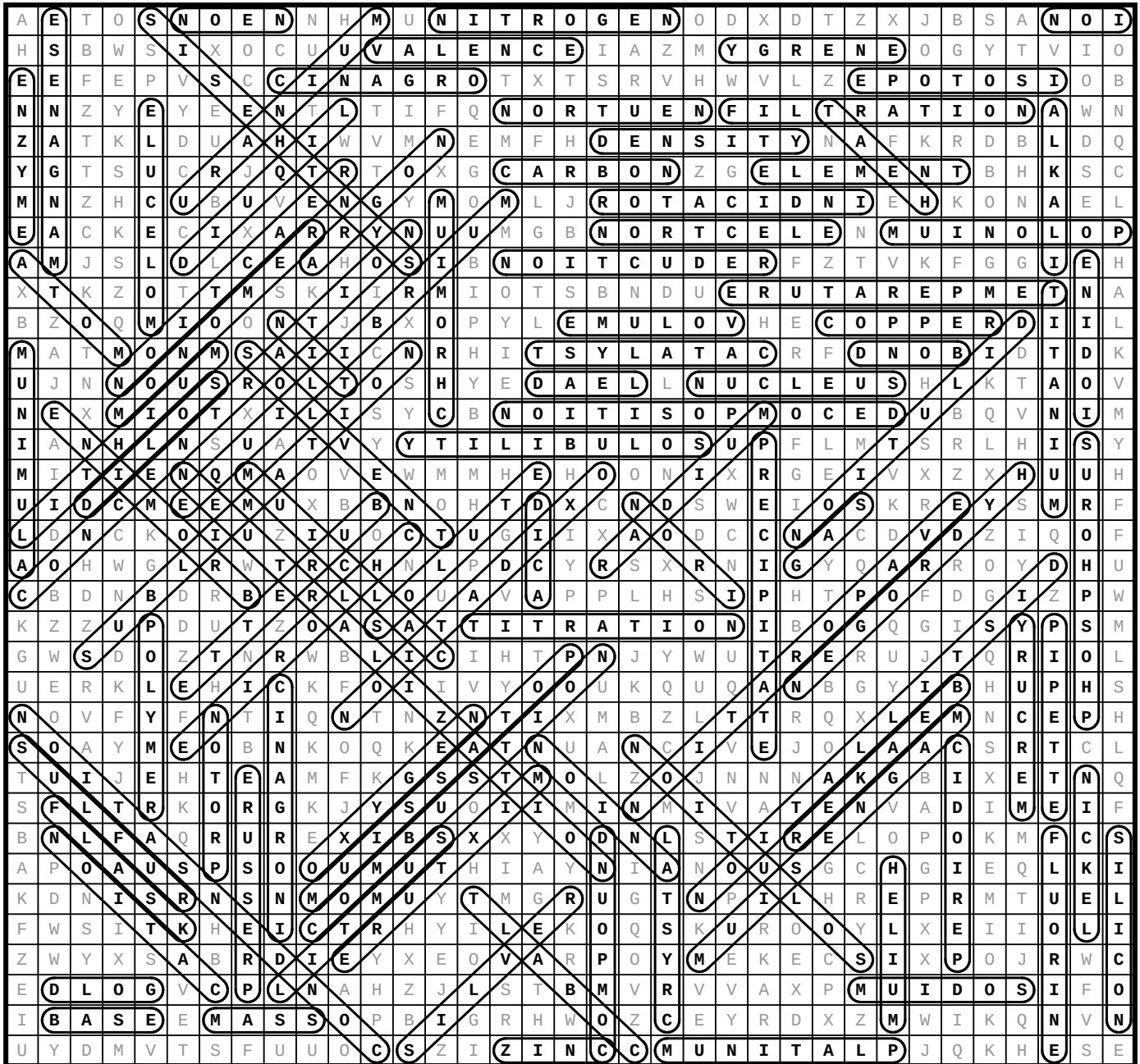

Did you know?

- Water is one of the few substances that becomes less dense as it freezes, which is why ice floats.
- A chemical reaction rearranges atoms into new substances but never creates or destroys the atoms themselves.
- The pH scale measures how acidic or basic a substance is, running from 0 to 14, with 7 considered neutral.
- Table salt is a compound made of two elements, sodium and chlorine, both of which are dangerous on their own.

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
