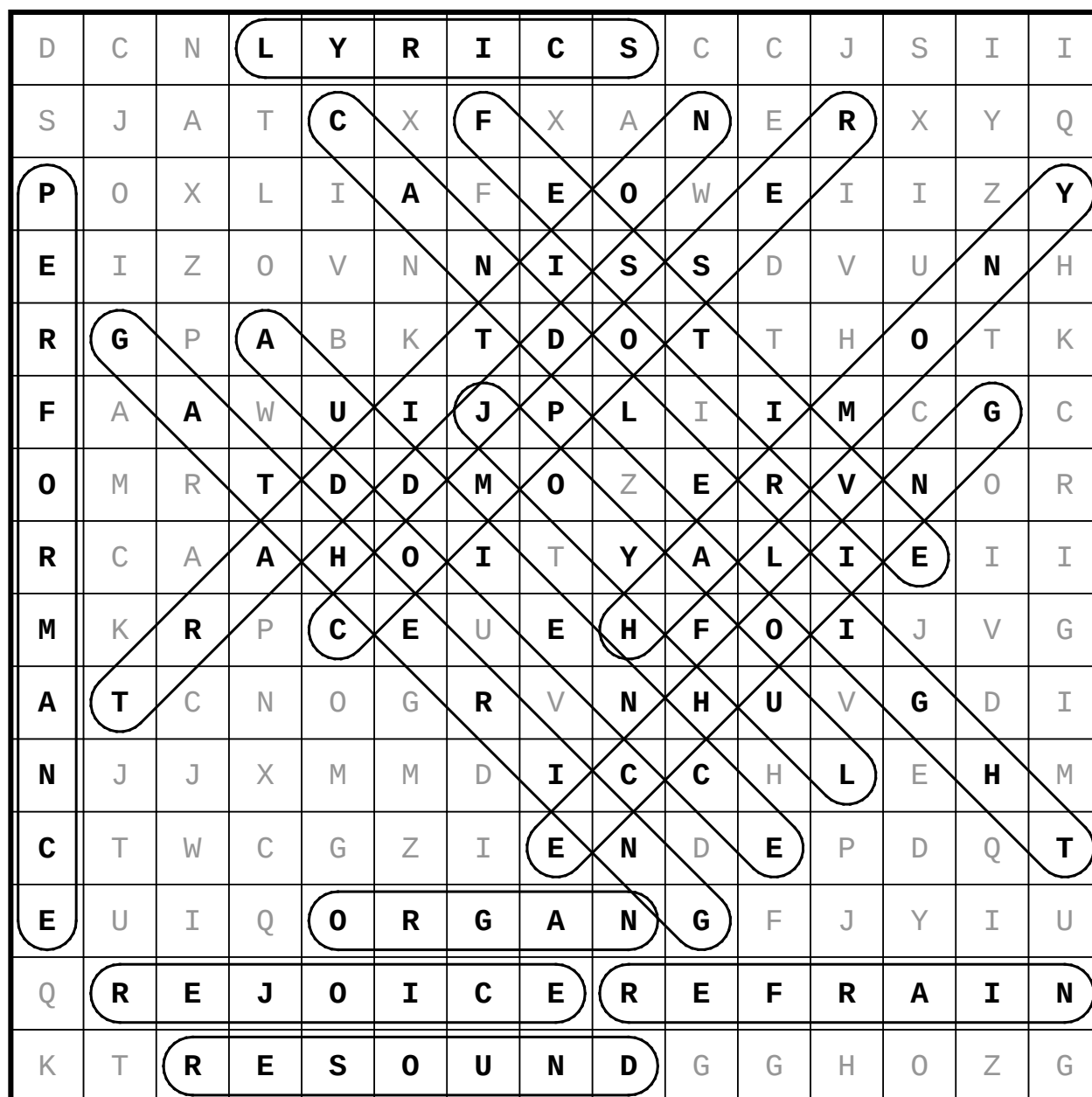

Did you know?

- Many well-known Christmas carols, like "Silent Night," were originally written in languages other than English.
- Caroling door-to-door has roots in older European traditions of wassailing, going house to house singing in exchange for food or drink.
- Some of today's most popular Christmas songs were actually written and released in the 20th century, not centuries ago.
- Church choirs have performed religious Christmas music for centuries, predating many of the more secular songs popular today.

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
