Did you know?

- The CPU is often called the "brain" of a computer, since it carries out most of the instructions a program gives it.
- RAM (Random Access Memory) is temporary storage that clears when a computer shuts down, unlike a hard drive.
- The first hard disk drive, built in 1956, was about the size of two refrigerators and stored just a few megabytes.
- A single modern graphics card can contain billions of tiny transistors, far more than an entire early computer.

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
