- Not every country's capital is its largest city; Australia's capital, Canberra, was purpose-built partly because Sydney and Melbourne couldn't agree on which should hold the role.
- Some countries have changed their capital city more than once throughout their history.
- A handful of countries, like Bolivia and South Africa, officially recognize more than one capital city, each with different government functions.
- Vatican City is unique in being both a capital and an entire country contained within a single city.

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
