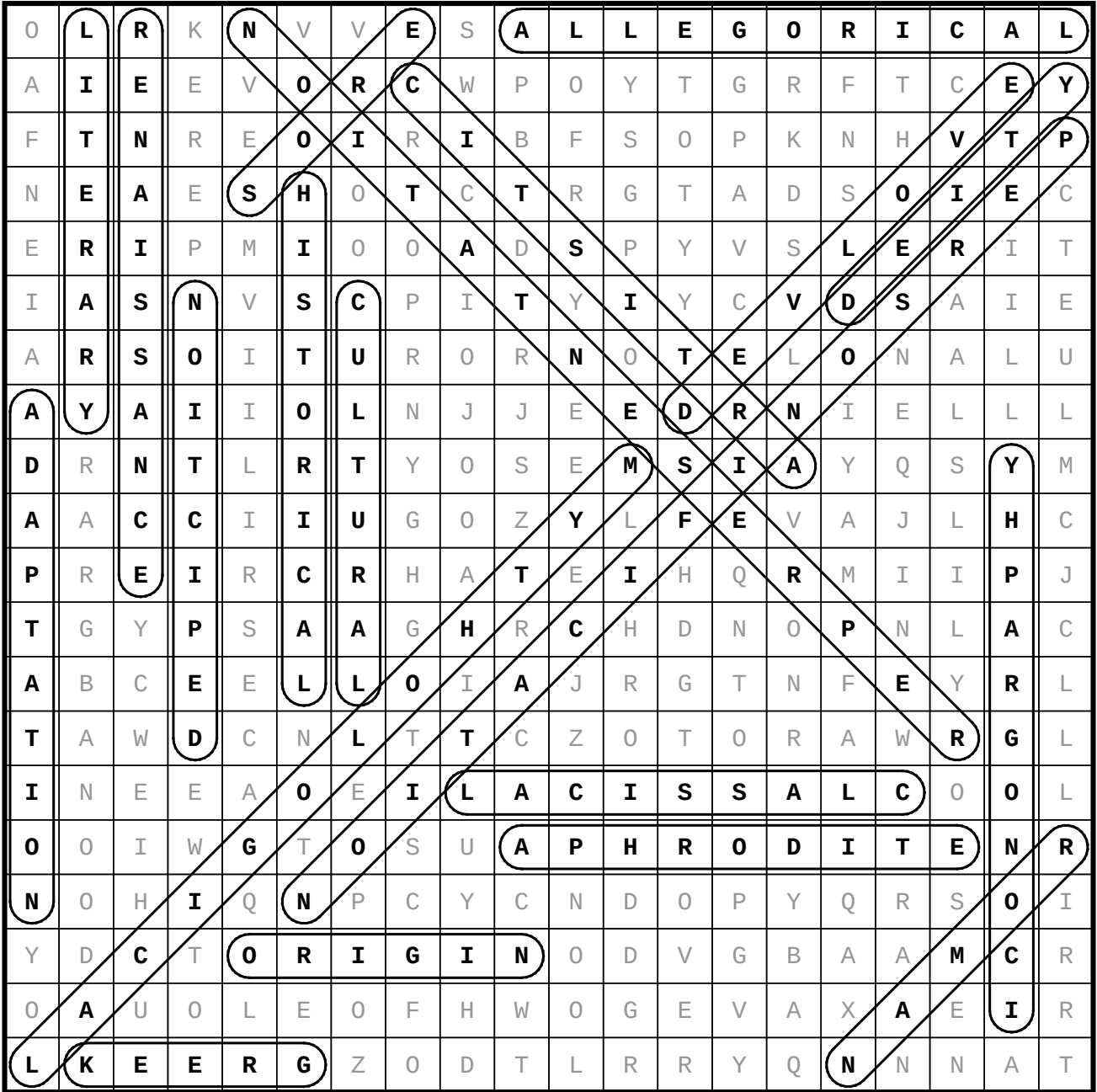

Did you know?

- Cupid is the Roman god of desire and affection, whose Greek counterpart is Eros, a similar figure from earlier mythology.
- Cupid is traditionally described as the son of Venus, the Roman goddess of love, whose Greek counterpart is Aphrodite.
- The image of Cupid as a chubby, winged infant became especially common starting in Renaissance art; earlier classical depictions often showed him as a young man.
- Cupid is sometimes depicted wearing a blindfold, a detail meant to suggest that love can be unpredictable or blind to reason.

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
