Did you know?

- Marshmallow Peeps were originally shaped entirely by hand, a process that took about 27 hours per batch before the company mechanized production in the early 1950s.
- Jelly beans became strongly associated specifically with Easter in the United States starting in the 1930s.
- A solid chocolate bunny uses more cocoa and weighs more than a hollow one of the same size, which is part of why hollow bunnies are more common and cheaper to produce.
- Many classic Easter candies, like jelly beans, are not tied to any religious meaning at all; they became associated with the holiday mainly through marketing and habit.

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
