Did you know?

- In parts of Poland and Hungary, an Easter Monday tradition involves playfully sprinkling water or perfume on others.
- In Greece, many people traditionally dye eggs red specifically, symbolizing the blood of Christ in Orthodox tradition.
- Because Easter always falls in the Southern Hemisphere's autumn, some countries there blend seasonal harvest imagery in alongside the usual spring symbols used elsewhere.
- Orthodox and Western churches often celebrate Easter on different dates because they calculate the holiday using different calendars.

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
