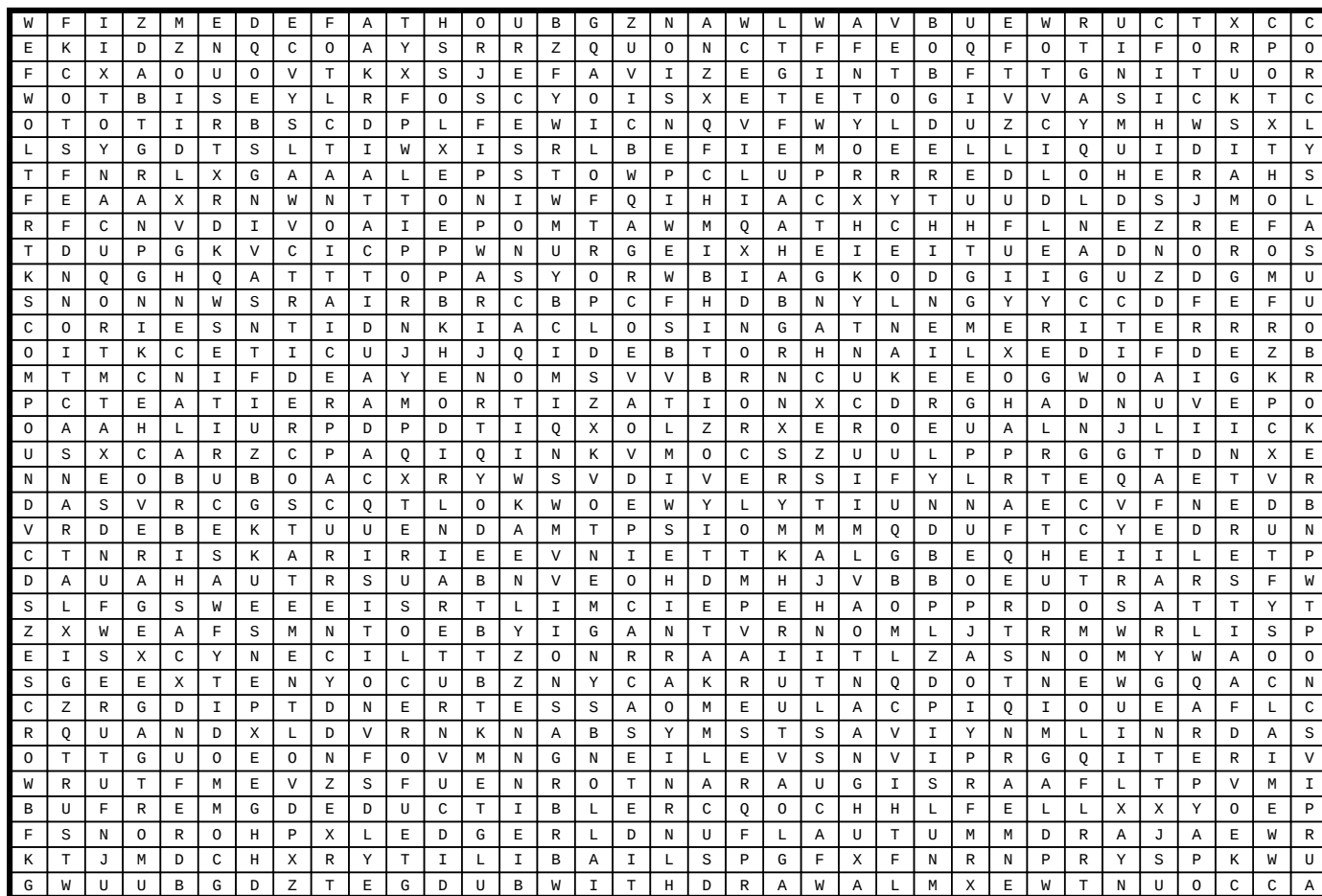

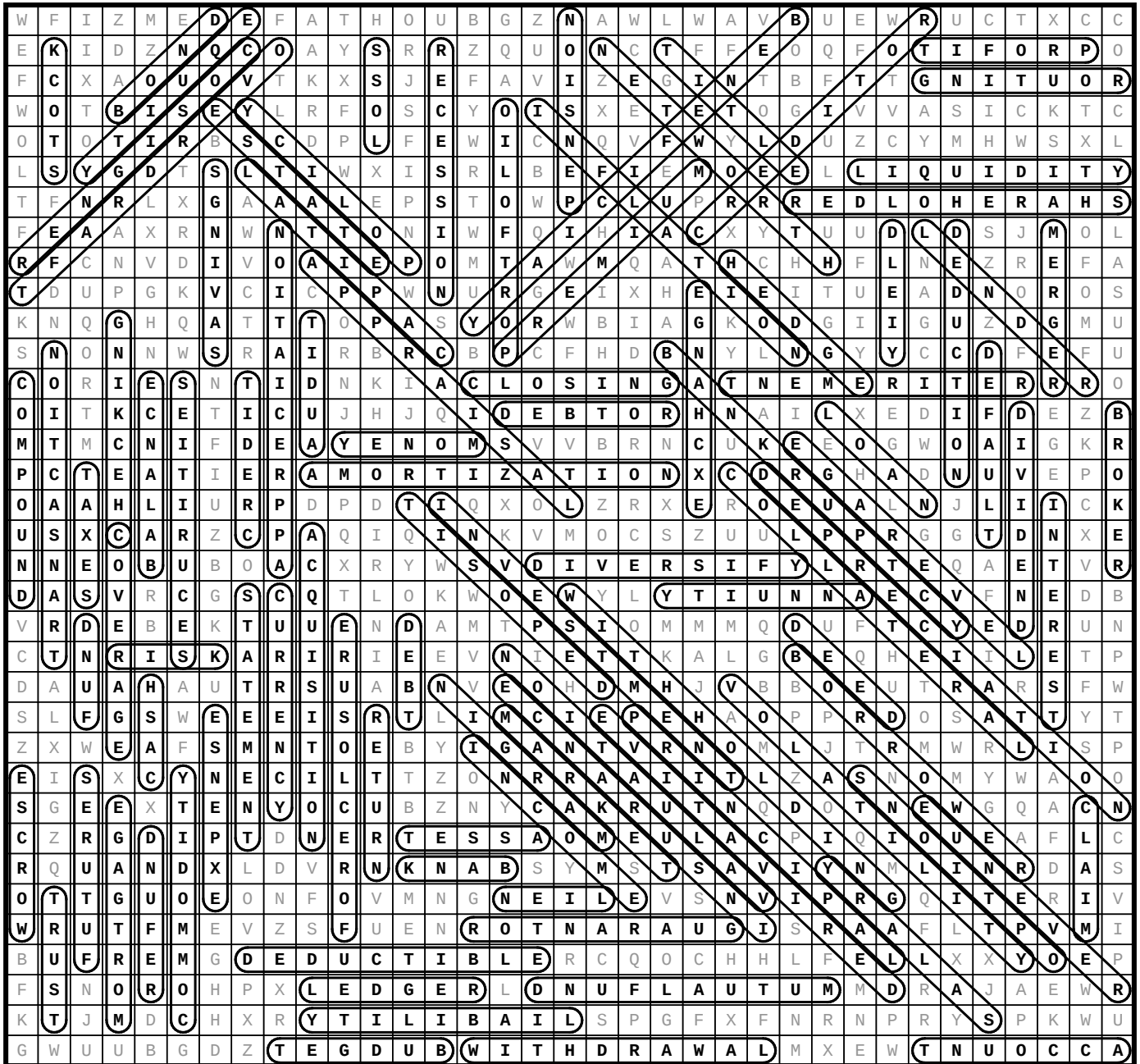

Did you know?

- Compound interest, sometimes called interest on interest, is why money saved early can grow far more than money saved later, even at the same rate.
- A credit score is a numerical summary of a persons borrowing history, used by lenders to judge financial risk.
- Diversifying a portfolio means spreading investments across different assets specifically to reduce risk if any single one performs poorly.
- Inflation gradually reduces the purchasing power of money over time, which is why the same amount of cash buys less in the future than it does today.

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
