Did you know?

- The chemical colors in fireworks come from specific metal compounds -- strontium for red, copper for blue, barium for green.
- China is credited with inventing fireworks over a thousand years ago, reportedly after bamboo was accidentally thrown into a fire.
- The loud boom from a firework comes from a rapid release of gas, not from the explosion of the shell itself.
- Some fireworks displays are synchronized to music using computer-controlled electronic launch systems.

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
