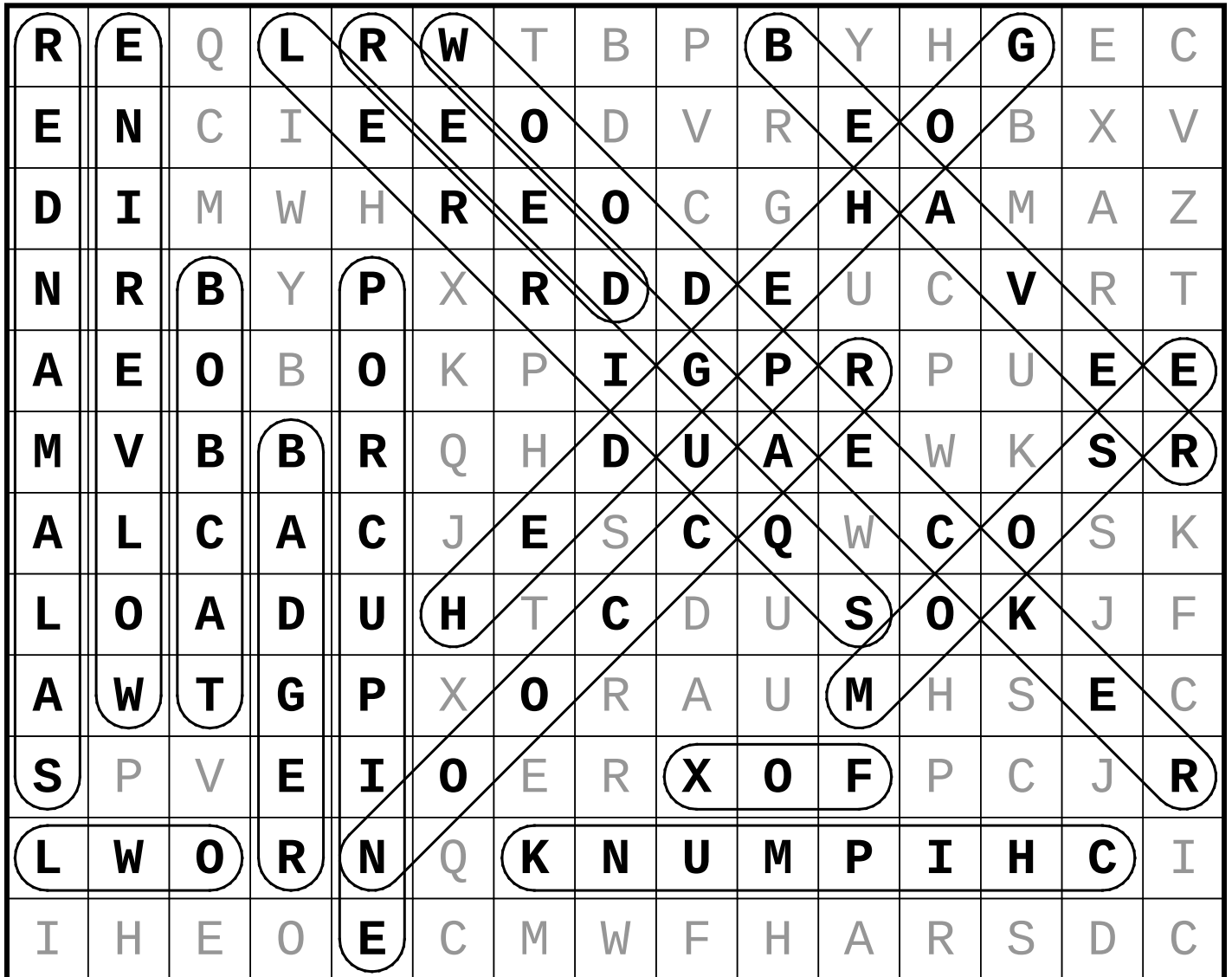

Did you know?

- Owls can rotate their heads up to about 270 degrees, compensating for eyes that can't move much in their sockets.
- Deer antlers are shed and regrown every year, unlike horns, which grow continuously.
- Woodpeckers have specially reinforced skulls that protect their brains from the repeated impact of pecking wood.
- Many forest animals rely on camouflage patterns specifically matched to bark, leaves or shadow to avoid predators.
