Did you know?

- Tadpoles breathe through gills, similar to fish, before developing lungs and losing them as they grow into adult frogs.
- A tadpole's tail doesn't simply fall off; the body actually reabsorbs it as part of a real process called resorption.
- Wood frogs can survive being partially frozen through winter, then thaw out again in spring and hop away.
- Frogs absorb water directly through their skin rather than drinking it, which is part of why healthy, moist skin matters so much to them.

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
