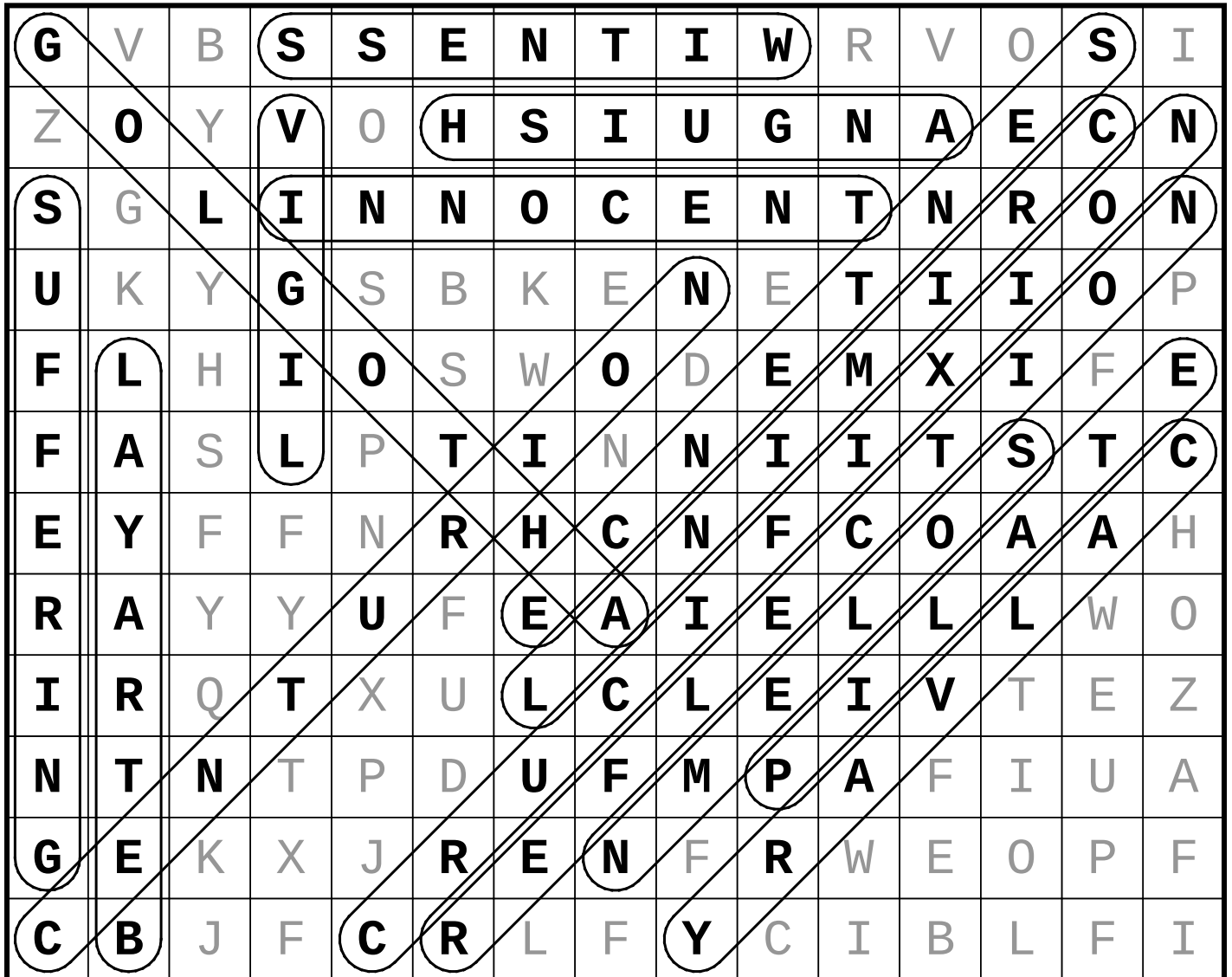

Did you know?

- Despite its name, Good Friday commemorates the crucifixion, a solemn rather than celebratory day in the Christian calendar.
- Many churches hold services at exactly 3 p.m. on Good Friday, traditionally regarded as the hour of the crucifixion.
- Some countries, including the United Kingdom and Germany, observe Good Friday as a public holiday, with many schools and businesses closed.
- Some scholars believe the word "good" in Good Friday may come from an older use of the word meaning "holy," rather than the more common modern sense.

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
