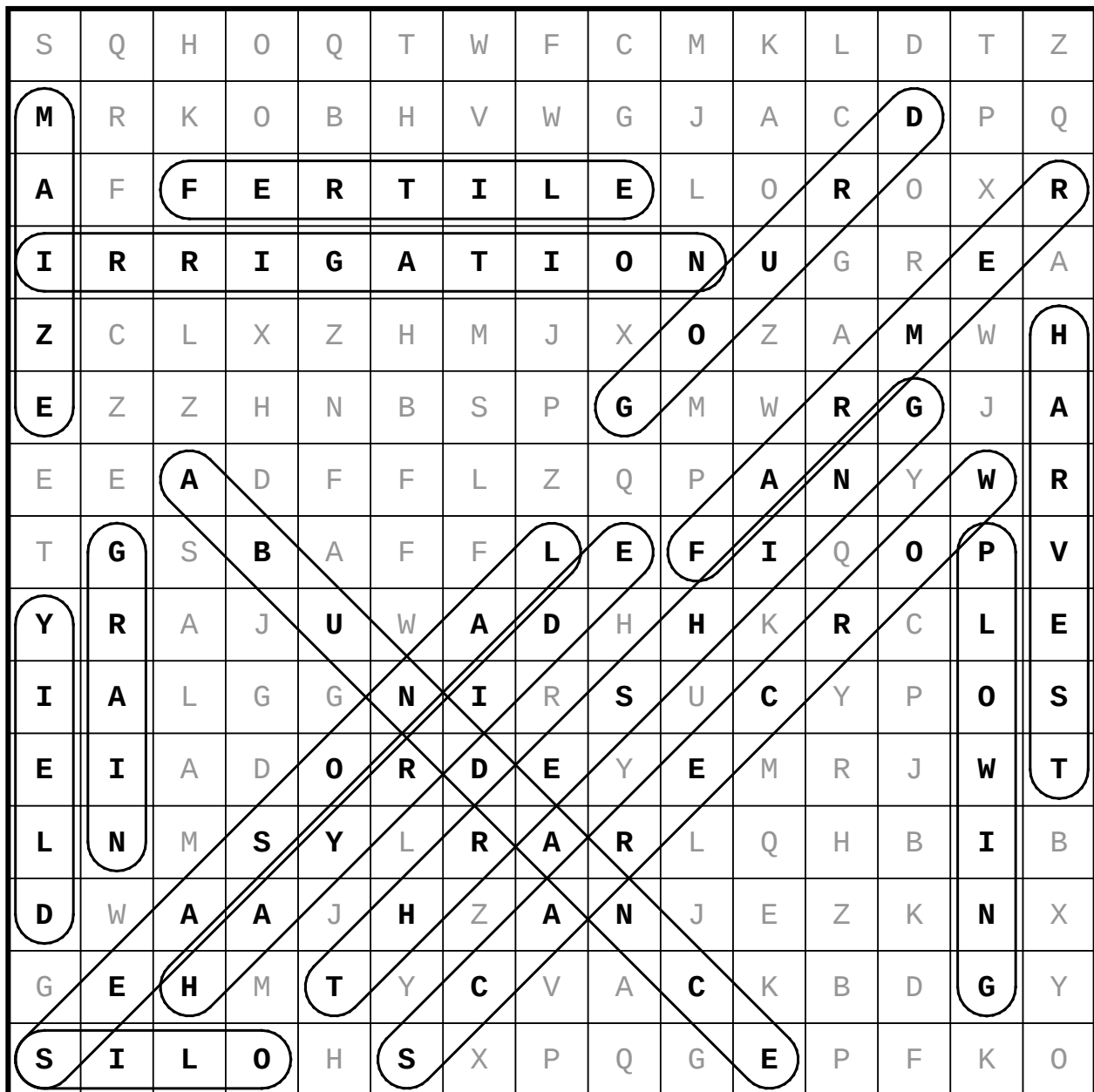

Did you know?

- The cornucopia, or "horn of plenty," is a symbol with roots in ancient Greek mythology, long before its association with Thanksgiving.
- Harvest festivals celebrating the end of the growing season are a tradition found in many cultures worldwide, not unique to America.
- The specific imagery of a cornucopia overflowing with fruit and vegetables became a popular Thanksgiving decoration in the 19th and 20th centuries.
- Many harvest symbols used at Thanksgiving, like corn and gourds, reflect crops genuinely native to North America.
