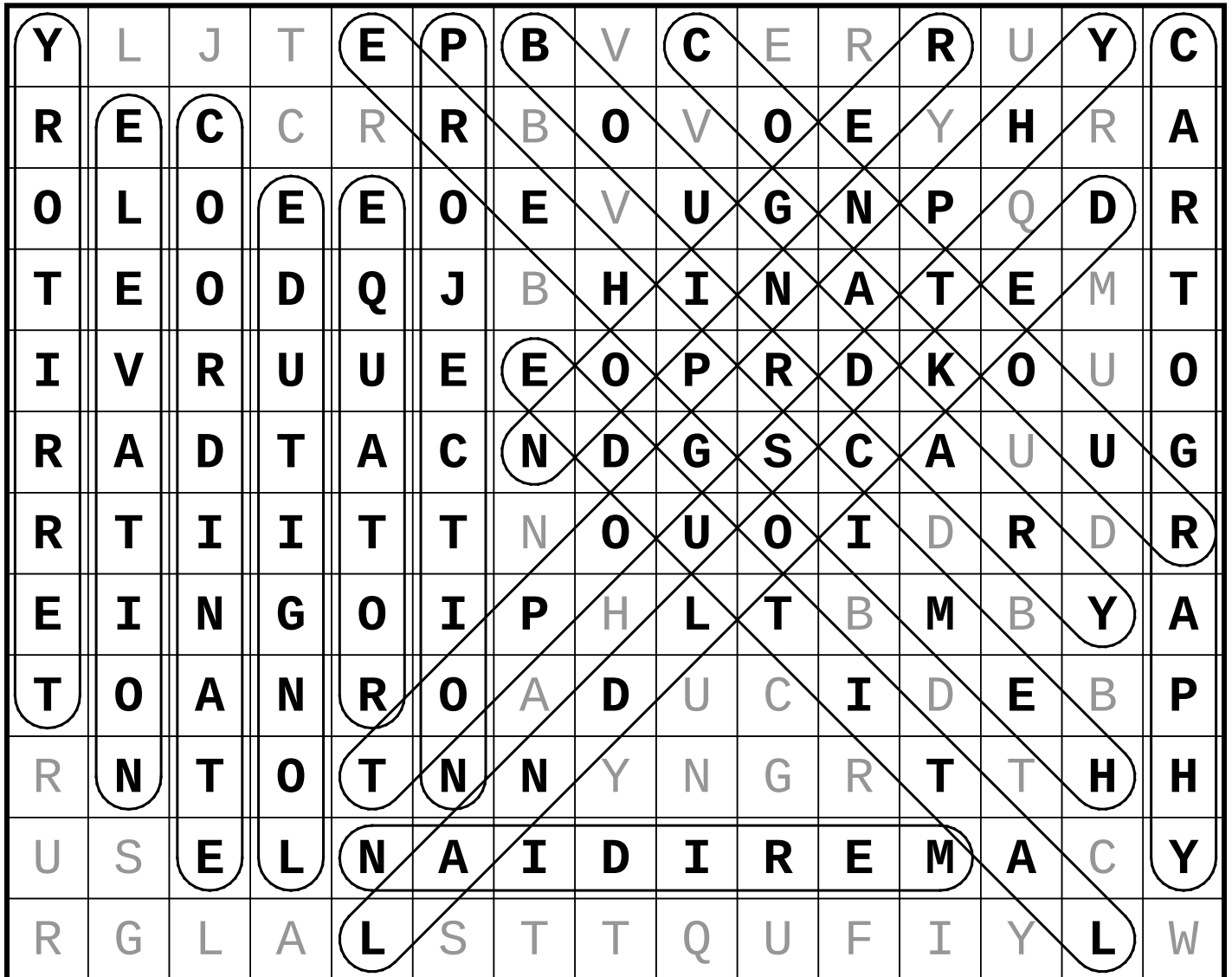

Did you know?

- A map's legend, or key, explains what each symbol used on the map actually represents.
- Latitude lines run east-west and measure distance north or south of the equator, while longitude lines run north-south.
- A map projection is the specific method used to represent the curved surface of the Earth on a flat map, and every method distorts something in the process.
- Scale on a map shows the real-world distance represented by a given distance on the page.

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
