Did you know?

- The metric system is based on units of ten, making conversions between units far simpler than in many older measurement systems.
 - A meter was originally defined based on the distance from the North Pole to the equator, though it is now defined using the speed of light.
 - Scientists worldwide largely rely on the same standard units specifically so that results from different countries can be compared directly.
 - Some units, like the degree Celsius, are named after the scientist who proposed them.
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
