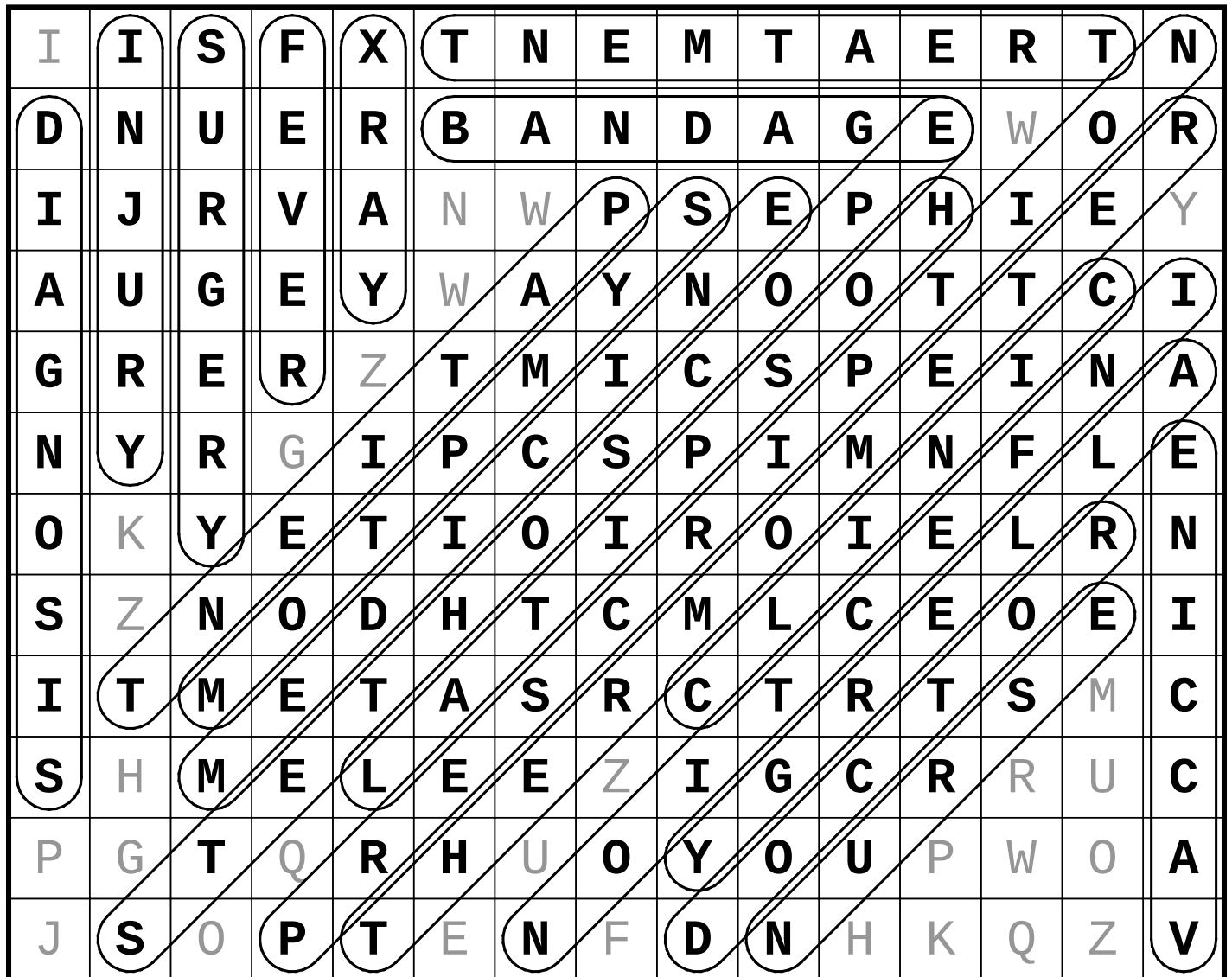

Did you know?

- The stethoscope was invented in 1816 by French physician René Laennec, originally made from a rolled paper tube.
- Antibiotics only work against bacterial infections, not viral ones, which is why they cannot treat illnesses like the common cold.
- The word "quarantine" comes from the Italian "quaranta giorni," meaning forty days, the length ships were once held offshore during plague outbreaks.
- Vaccines work by training the immune system to recognize a pathogen without causing the actual disease.

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
