Did you know?

- Mount Everest, the tallest mountain above sea level, continues to grow slightly taller each year due to ongoing tectonic activity.
- The Andes, running along South America's western edge, form the longest continental mountain range in the world.
- Measured from base to peak rather than sea level, Mauna Kea in Hawaii is actually taller than Mount Everest.
- Mountain ranges often form where two of Earth's tectonic plates collide and push the ground upward.

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
