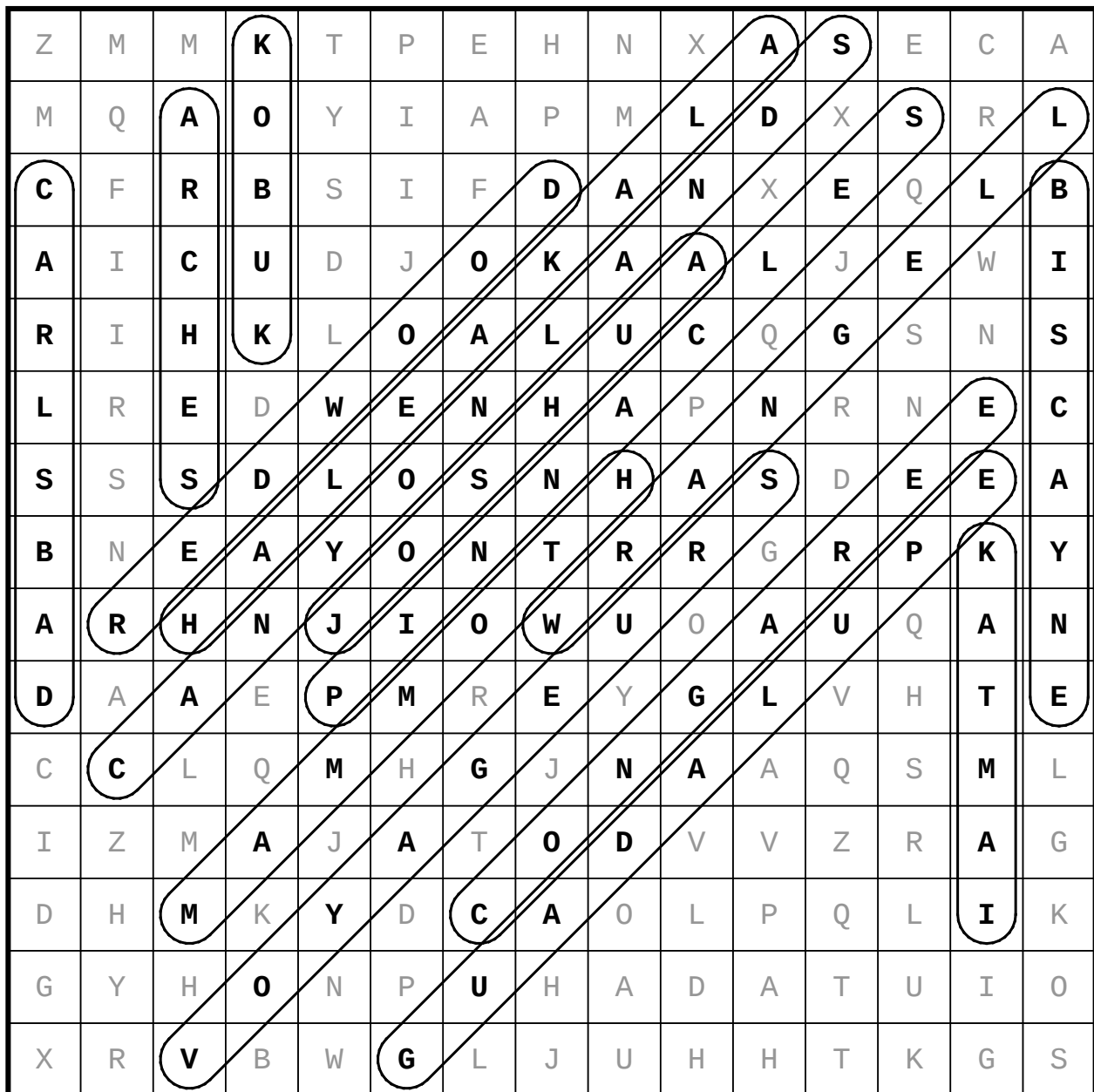

Did you know?

- Yellowstone, established in 1872, is widely considered the first national park in the world.
- Many national parks are specifically protected to preserve unique ecosystems, wildlife or geological features found nowhere else.
- Some national parks span international borders, jointly managed and protected by more than one country.
- National parks often restrict development and hunting specifically to keep natural habitats intact for future generations.

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
