Did you know?

- The northern lights happen when charged particles from the sun collide with gases in Earth's atmosphere, releasing light as a result.
- Different gases in the atmosphere produce different aurora colors; oxygen tends to produce green and red, while nitrogen contributes blues and purples.
- The same phenomenon happens near the South Pole too, where it is called the southern lights, or aurora australis, rather than the aurora borealis.
- Strong solar activity can push auroras to appear much farther from the poles than usual, occasionally making them visible at surprisingly low latitudes.
