Did you know?

- Pizza margherita is often said to have been named after Queen Margherita of Italy in the late 1800s, its colors matching the Italian flag.
- Pineapple as a pizza topping, despite the debate around it, was popularized in Canada in the 1960s.
- Mozzarella remains the most common cheese used on pizza specifically because of how well it melts and stretches.
- Toppings are traditionally added in a specific order, with sauce and cheese as a base layer before other ingredients.

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
