Did you know?

- A polar bear's fur only looks white; the individual hairs are actually translucent, and its skin underneath is black.
- Polar bears are strong swimmers and have been recorded swimming for many hours, or even days, at a stretch between ice floes.
- Scientists classify polar bears as marine mammals, since they depend on sea ice and the ocean for most of their hunting.
- A polar bear's sense of smell is powerful enough to detect a seal's breathing hole in the ice from a considerable distance away.

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
