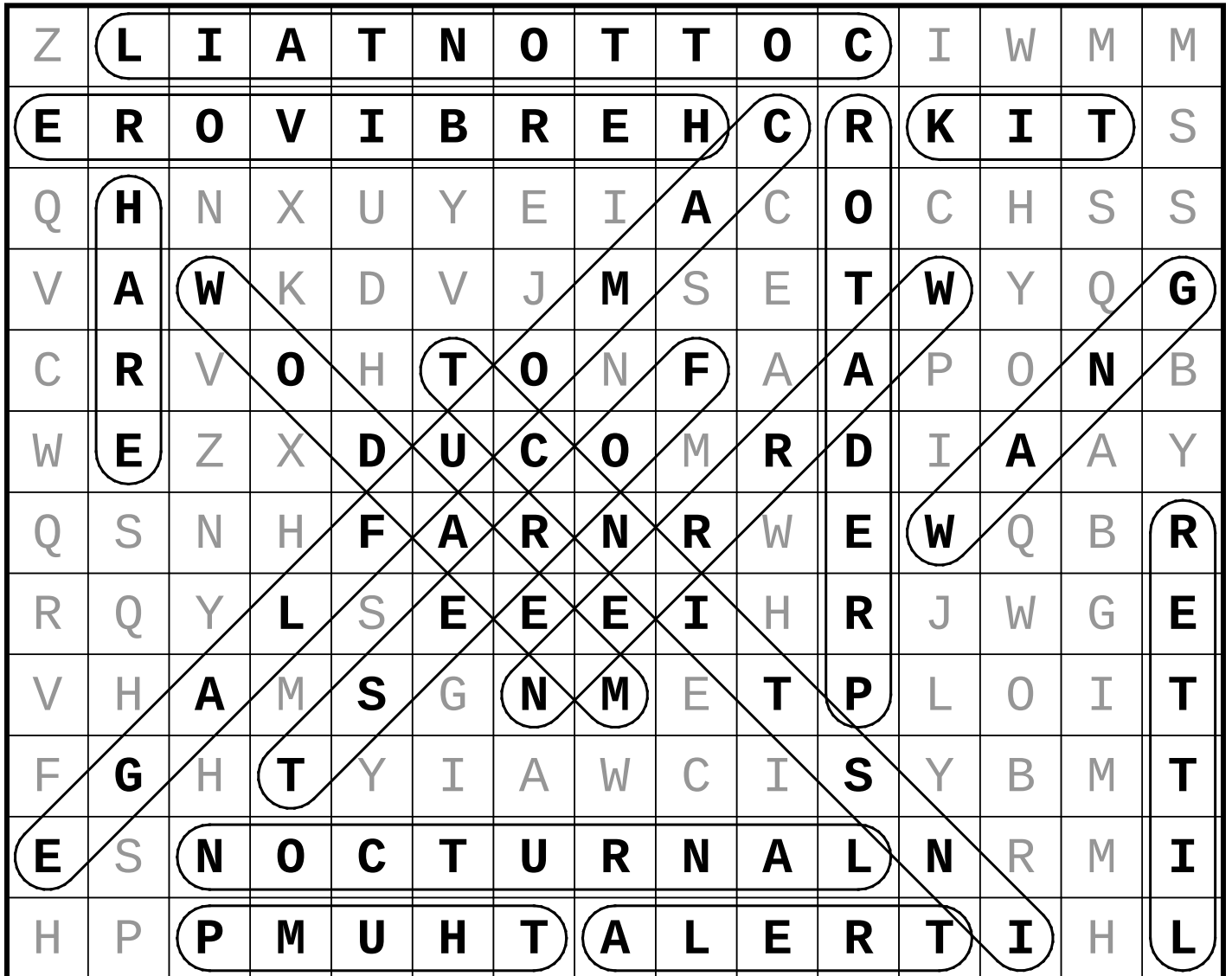

Rabbits — Answer Key



Did you know?

- Rabbits are technically not rodents; they belong to a separate group called lagomorphs, along with hares and pikas.
- Rabbits re-eat a special type of soft dropping called a cecotrope to get extra nutrients from their food a second time.
- A group of rabbits living together underground is called a warren, a term also used for the tunnels themselves.
- Wild rabbits are most active at dawn and dusk, a pattern called crepuscular behavior, not strictly nocturnal.

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
