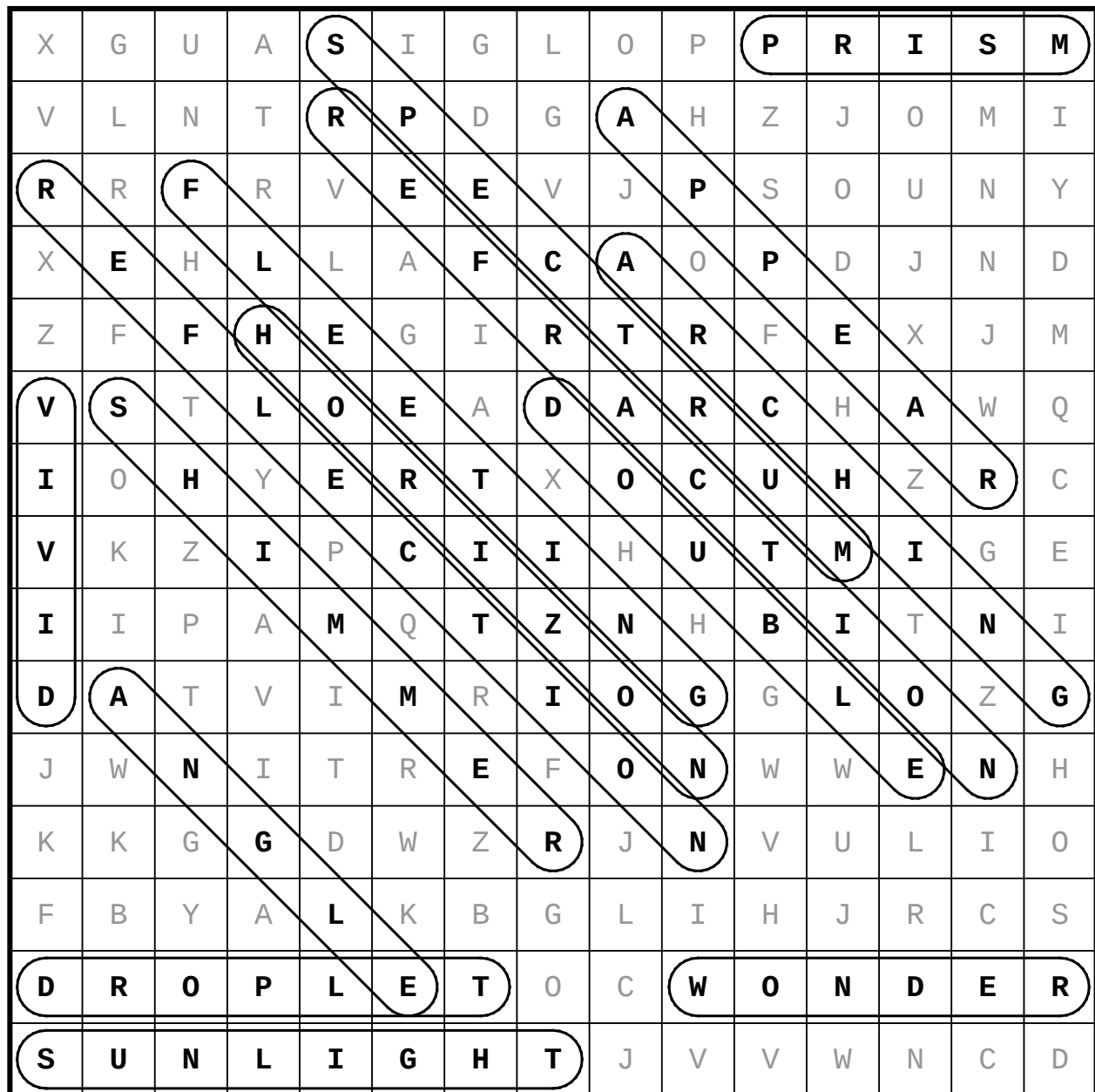

# Rainbows — Answer Key



## Did you know?

- A rainbow doesn't actually touch the ground at a specific spot; its apparent position depends entirely on where the viewer is standing.
- No two people ever see exactly the same rainbow, since each person's unique viewing angle creates a slightly different personal rainbow.
- A double rainbow shows its second, fainter arc with the colors reversed compared to the brighter, primary rainbow.
- A rainbow requires both rain and direct sunlight at the same time, which is why they typically appear opposite the sun in the sky.

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
