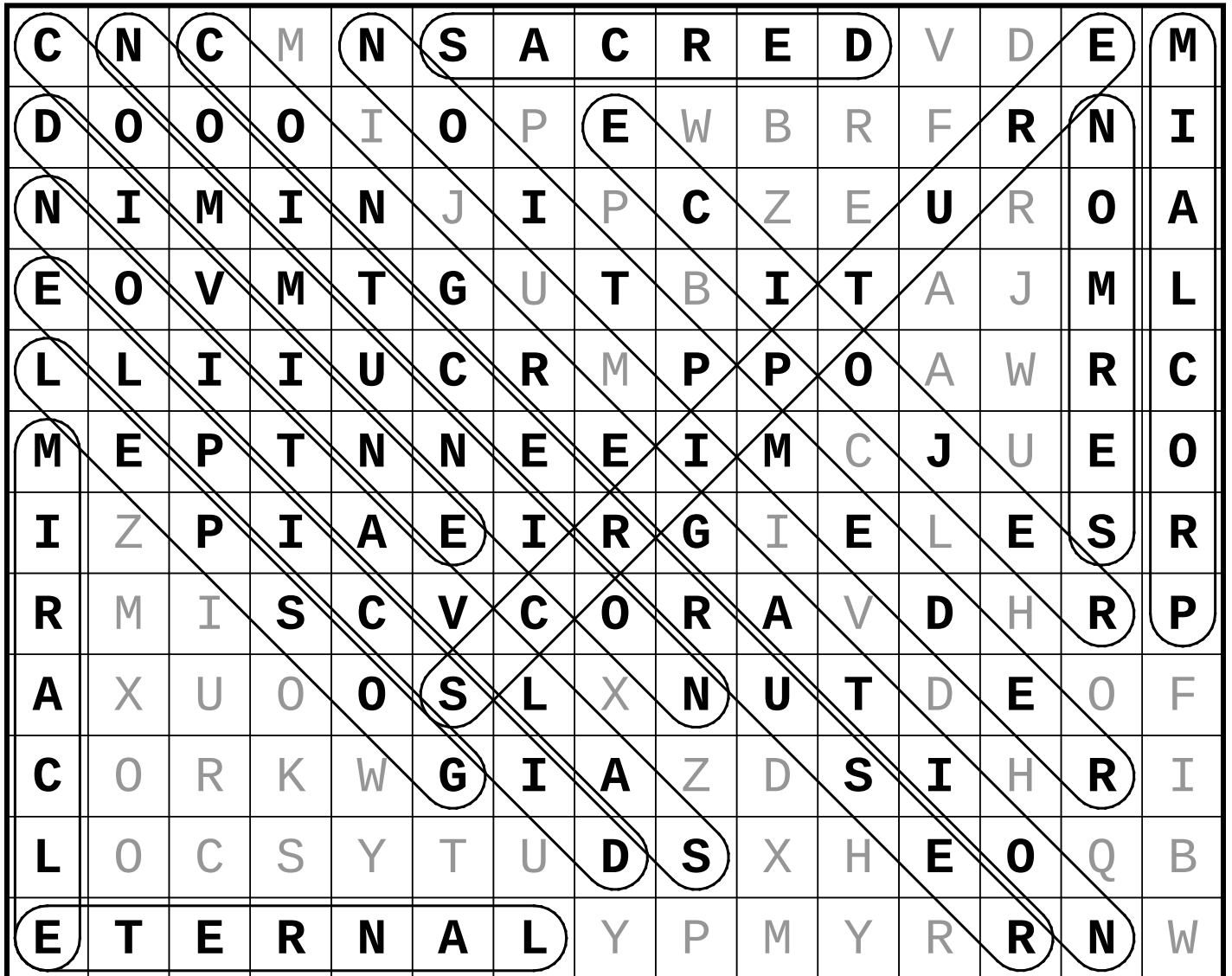

Did you know?

- The word "Paschal," often used in Easter hymns and titles, comes from the same root as the Hebrew word for Passover.
- Easter Sunday marks the end of Lent, a 40-day period of preparation observed by many Christian traditions.
- Sunrise services, held outdoors at dawn on Easter morning, are a specifically American Protestant tradition that developed in the 18th and 19th centuries.
- Many churches use white and gold decorations specifically on Easter Sunday, colors traditionally associated with celebration and purity in Christian liturgy.

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
