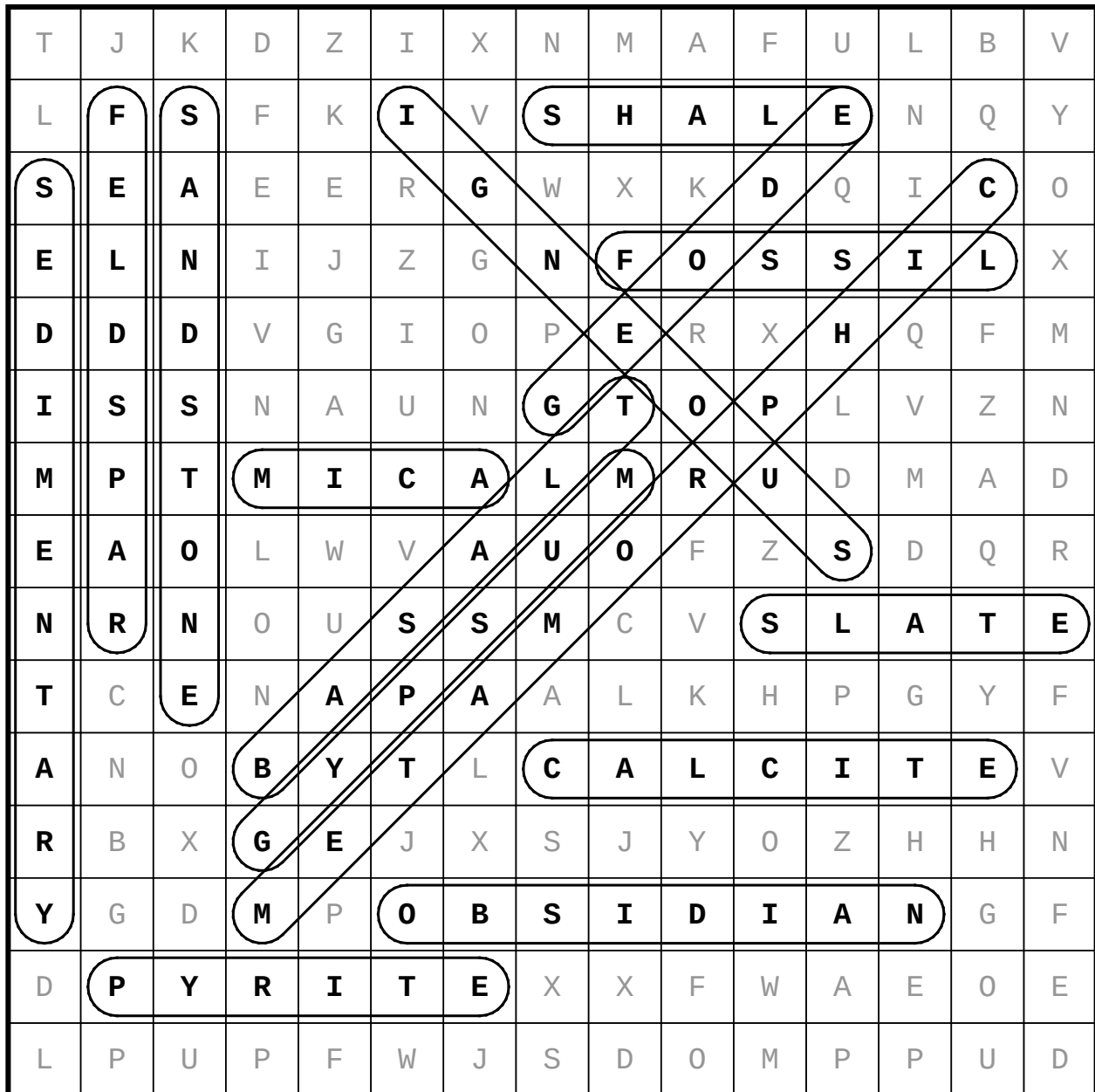

Did you know?

- Rocks are classified into three main types based on how they form: igneous, sedimentary and metamorphic.
- Diamond is the hardest known natural mineral, while talc is one of the softest.
- Obsidian, a naturally occurring volcanic glass, forms when lava cools so quickly that crystals don't have time to form.
- Fossils are typically found in sedimentary rock, since it forms in layers that can preserve remains over long periods.

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
