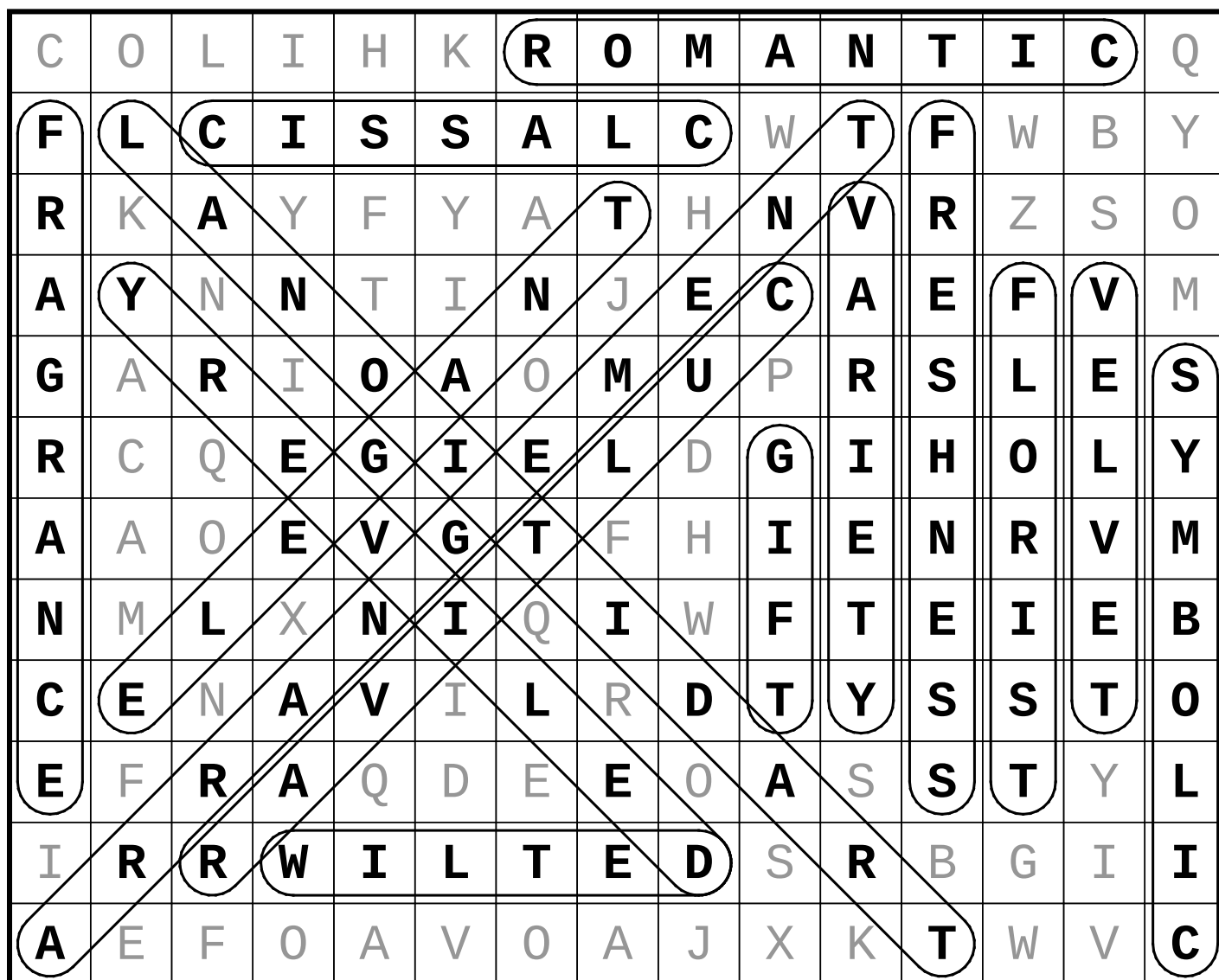

Roses — Answer Key



Did you know?

- Rose color has long carried different traditional meanings among florists: red for romantic love, yellow for friendship, and white often for purity or remembrance.
- Roses belong to the same plant family, Rosaceae, as apples, cherries, and several other common fruits.
- What people usually call a rose's "thorns" are technically prickles, since true thorns are modified branches, a distinction from a botanist's point of view.
- The specific tradition of giving red roses as a romantic gesture was reinforced in the 1800s through the popular "language of flowers," where different blooms were assigned symbolic meanings.

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
