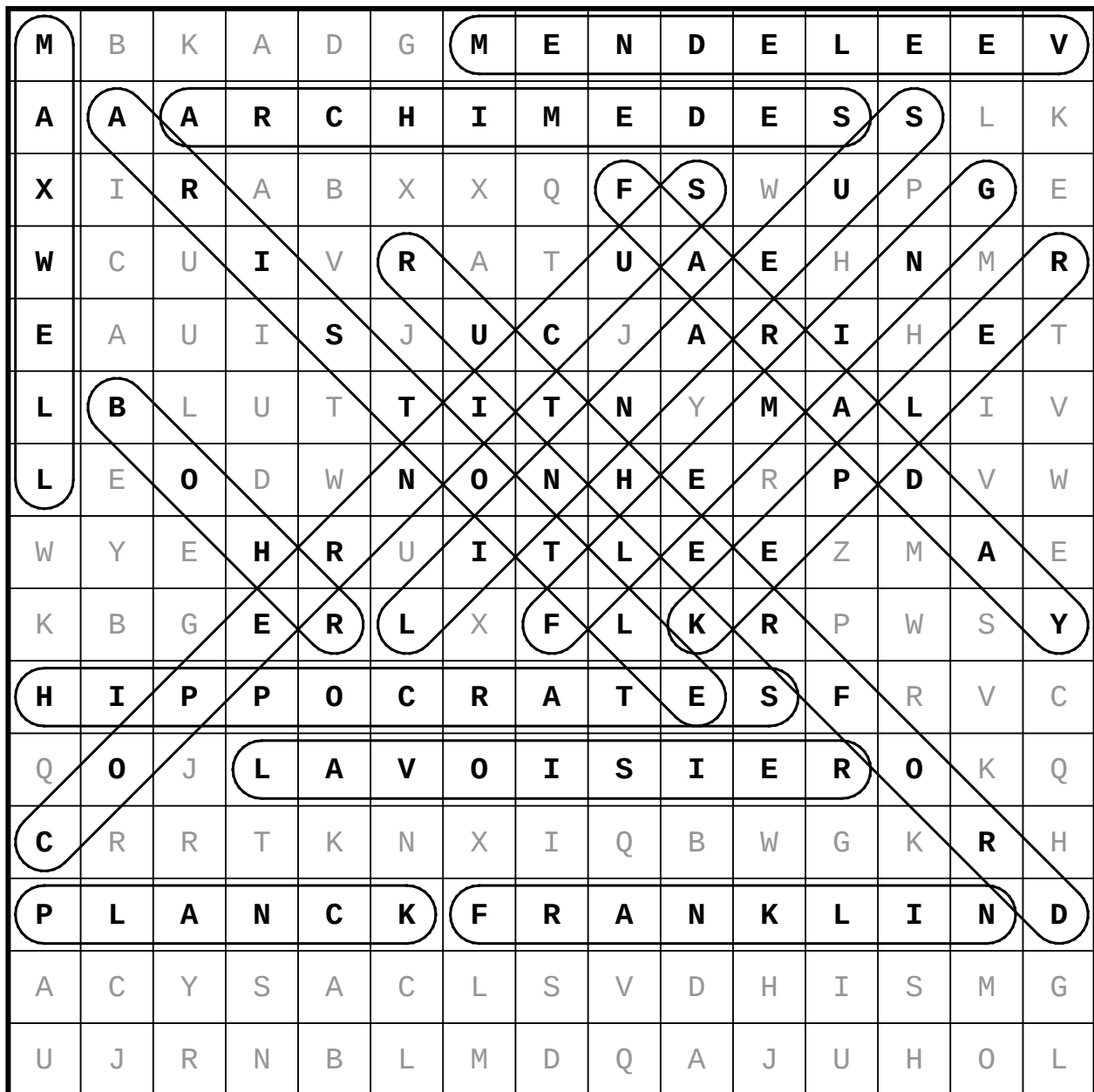

- Marie Curie remains the only person to win Nobel Prizes in two different sciences, physics and chemistry.
- Many major scientific discoveries were made by researchers building directly on the failed experiments of others before them.
- Scientific credit sometimes arrives decades after a discovery is first made, once other researchers can confirm it.

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
