Seeds and Plants — Answer Key



Did you know?

- Some seeds can remain dormant for a remarkably long time; one documented lotus seed reportedly germinated after being stored for over a thousand years.
- A seed needs specific conditions, usually the right moisture, temperature and sometimes light, to actually break dormancy and begin growing.
- The first leaf-like structure inside a seed is called a cotyledon, which provides early nourishment before true leaves develop.
- Seeds disperse in genuinely different ways depending on the plant: some travel by wind, others by animals eating fruit, and some simply by water.

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
