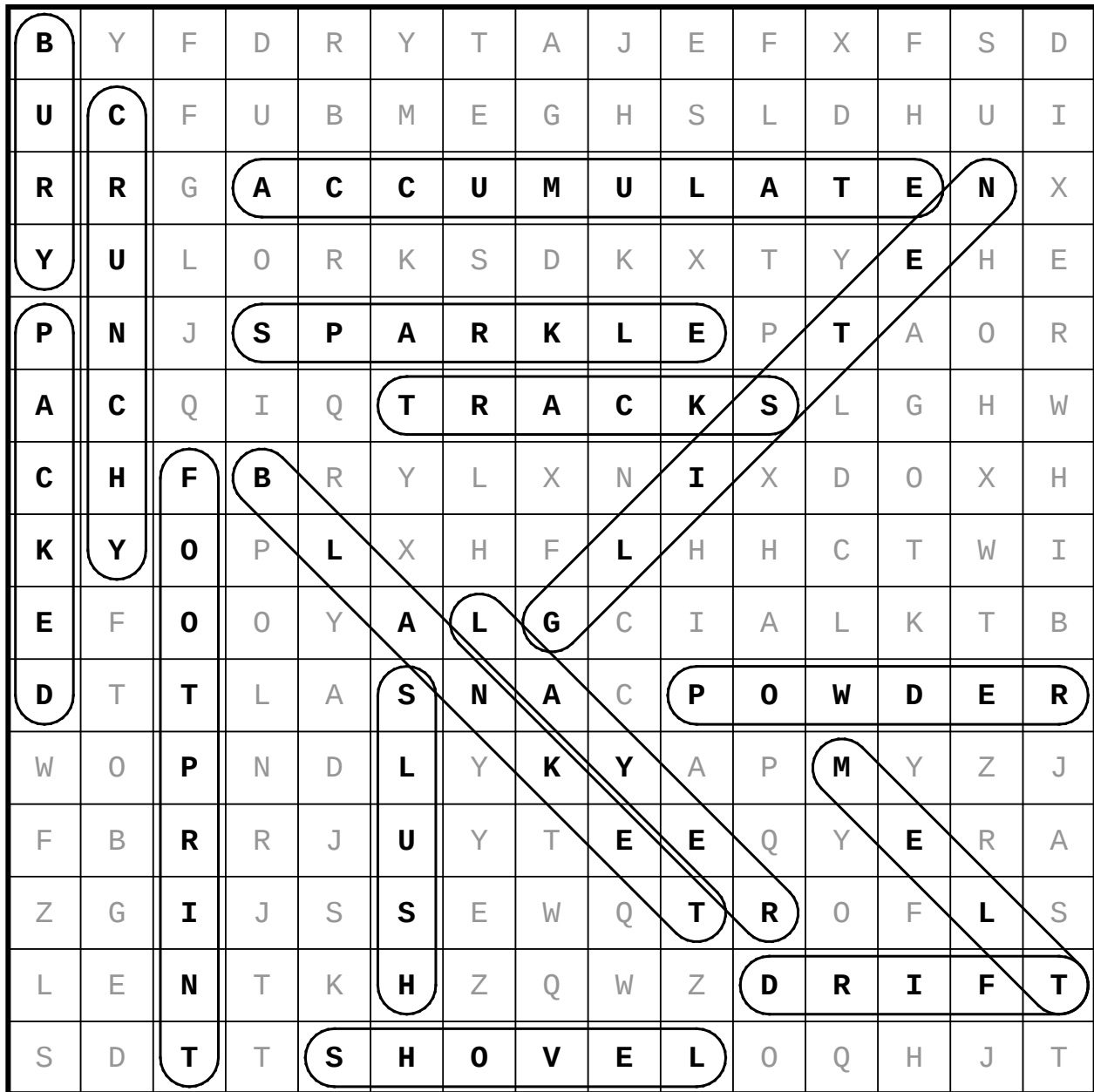

Snow — Answer Key



Did you know?

- A single snowstorm can drop billions of individual snow crystals, though most melt or merge before ever being counted or studied.
- Freshly fallen snow is mostly trapped air, which is part of why it muffles sound and feels lighter than the same volume of ice.
- Snow can appear to squeak underfoot in very cold temperatures because the ice crystals resist sliding smoothly past each other.
- The exact makeup of a snowpack changes over time as older layers compact and partially melt and refreeze, a process scientists actually study to predict avalanches.

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
