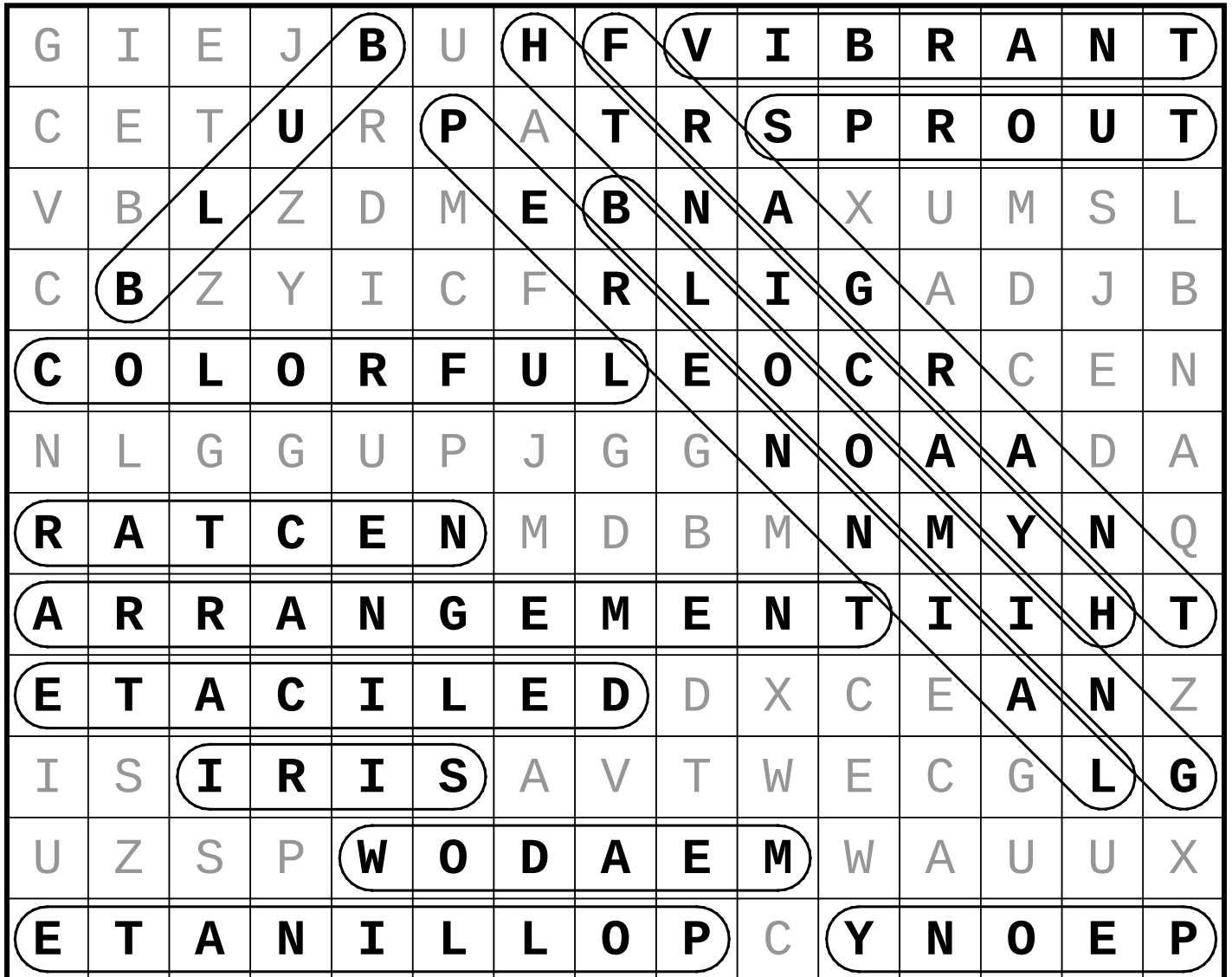

Did you know?

- Tulip bulbs must go through a period of cold weather before they are able to bloom, which is part of why they flower in spring.
- Daffodils contain a natural toxin, which is part of why deer and rabbits tend to leave them alone in the garden.
- Tulips are strongly associated with the Netherlands today, but they actually originated in Central Asia before spreading to Europe.
- Crocuses are often among the very first flowers to bloom each year, sometimes appearing while there is still snow on the ground.

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
