Did you know?

- Meteorologists and astronomers define the start of spring differently: meteorological spring always begins on March 1, while astronomical spring begins with the equinox, around March 20.
- The word "spring" for the season comes from the old idea of plants "springing up" from the ground after winter.
- In the Southern Hemisphere, spring happens in September through November, the opposite months from the Northern Hemisphere.
- Daylight hours increase noticeably throughout spring, a real, measurable change driven by Earth's tilt, not just a feeling.

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
