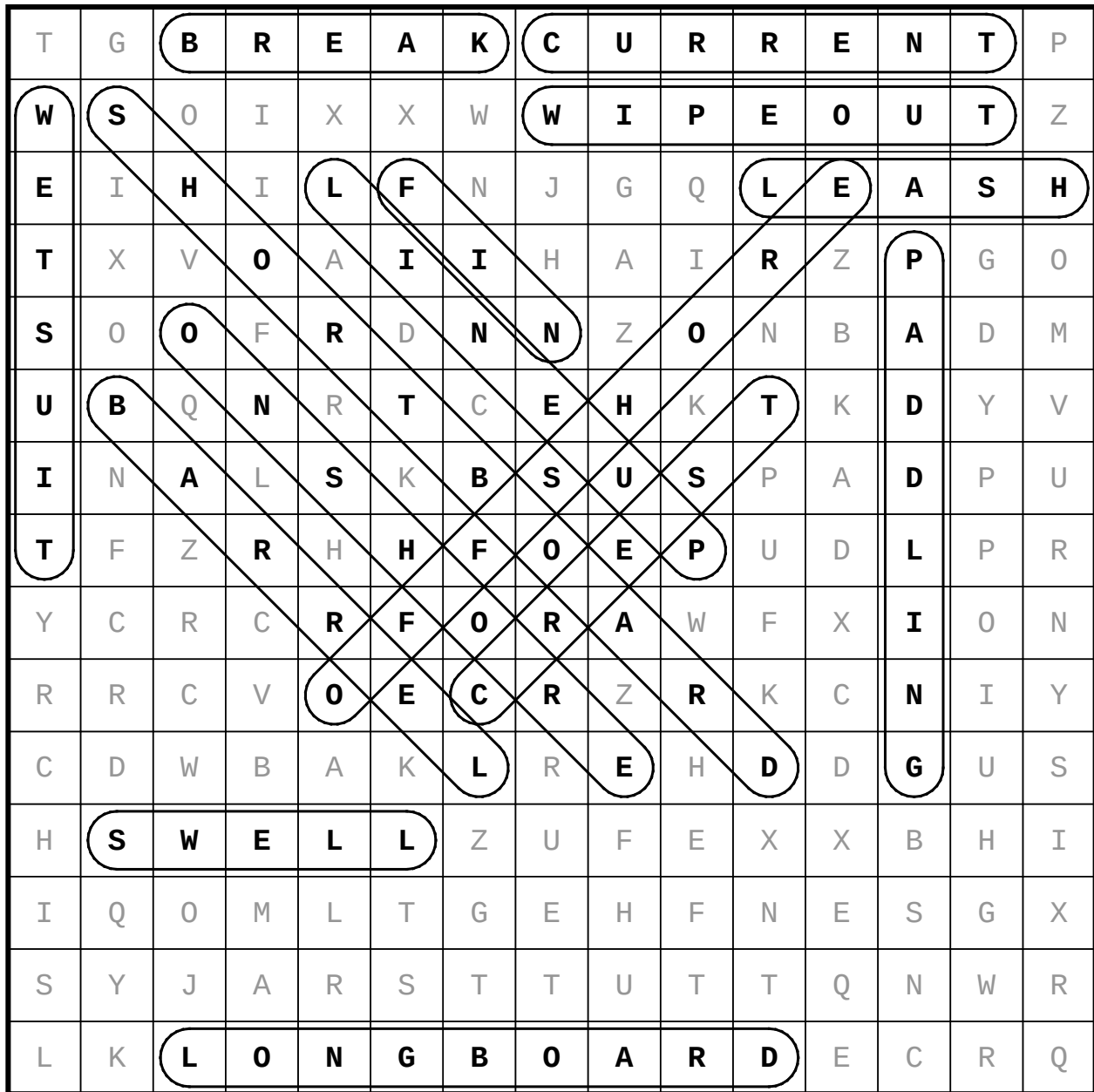

- Surfing is believed to have originated in Polynesia, with some of its earliest documented practice in ancient Hawaii.
- Waves used for surfing are primarily created by wind blowing across open ocean water, sometimes from storms thousands of miles away.
- A surfboard's fins help provide stability and control, similar to a keel on a boat.
- Big wave surfers sometimes use personal watercraft to get towed into waves too fast to paddle into on their own.

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
