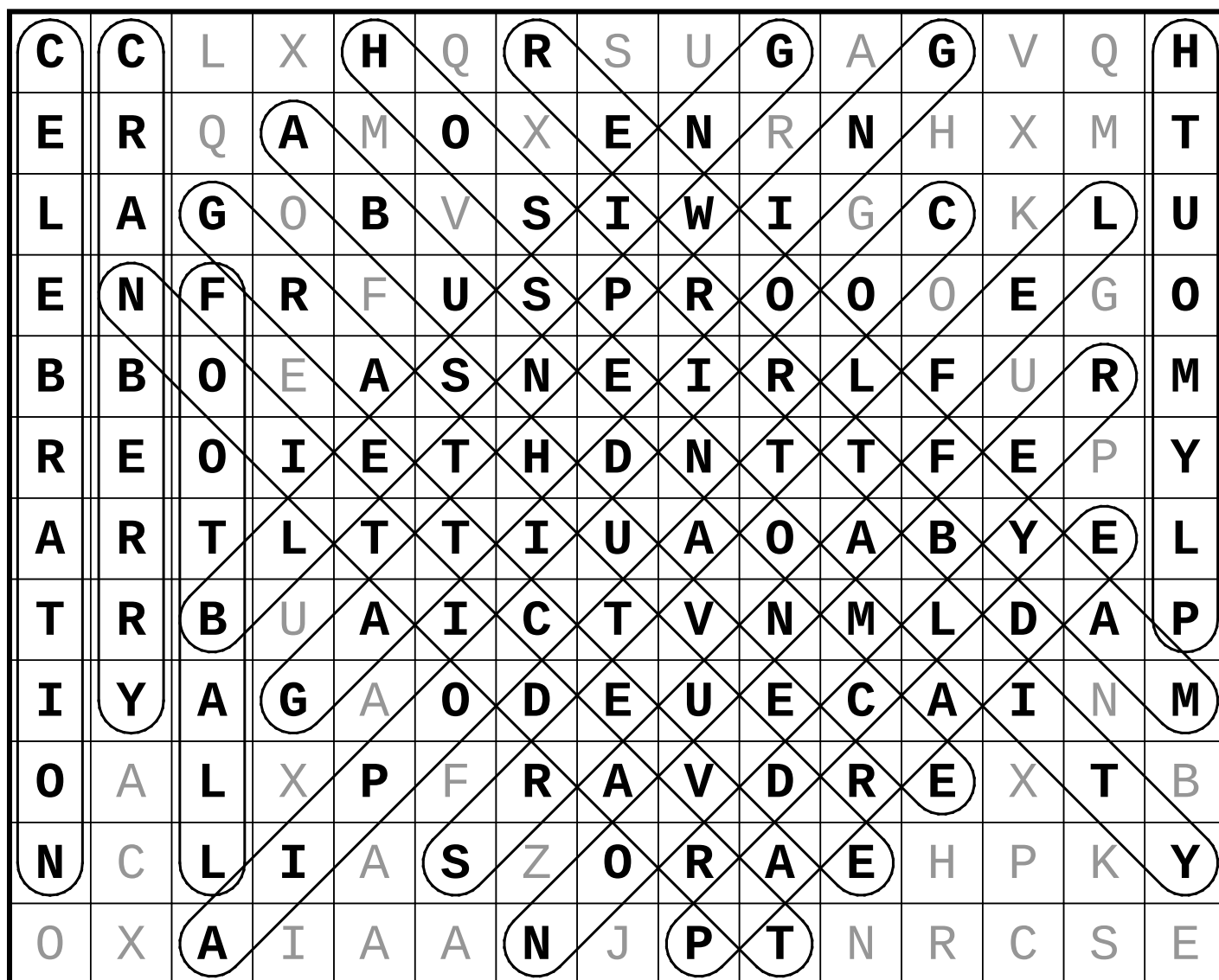

Did you know?

- Thanksgiving became an official annual U.S. holiday in 1863, proclaimed by President Abraham Lincoln during the Civil War.
- The holiday is traditionally linked to a 1621 harvest gathering between Plymouth colonists and the Wampanoag people, though the full history is more complex than the popular story suggests.
- Thanksgiving is always observed on the fourth Thursday of November in the United States.
- Canada celebrates its own distinct Thanksgiving holiday, observed on a different date in October.

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
