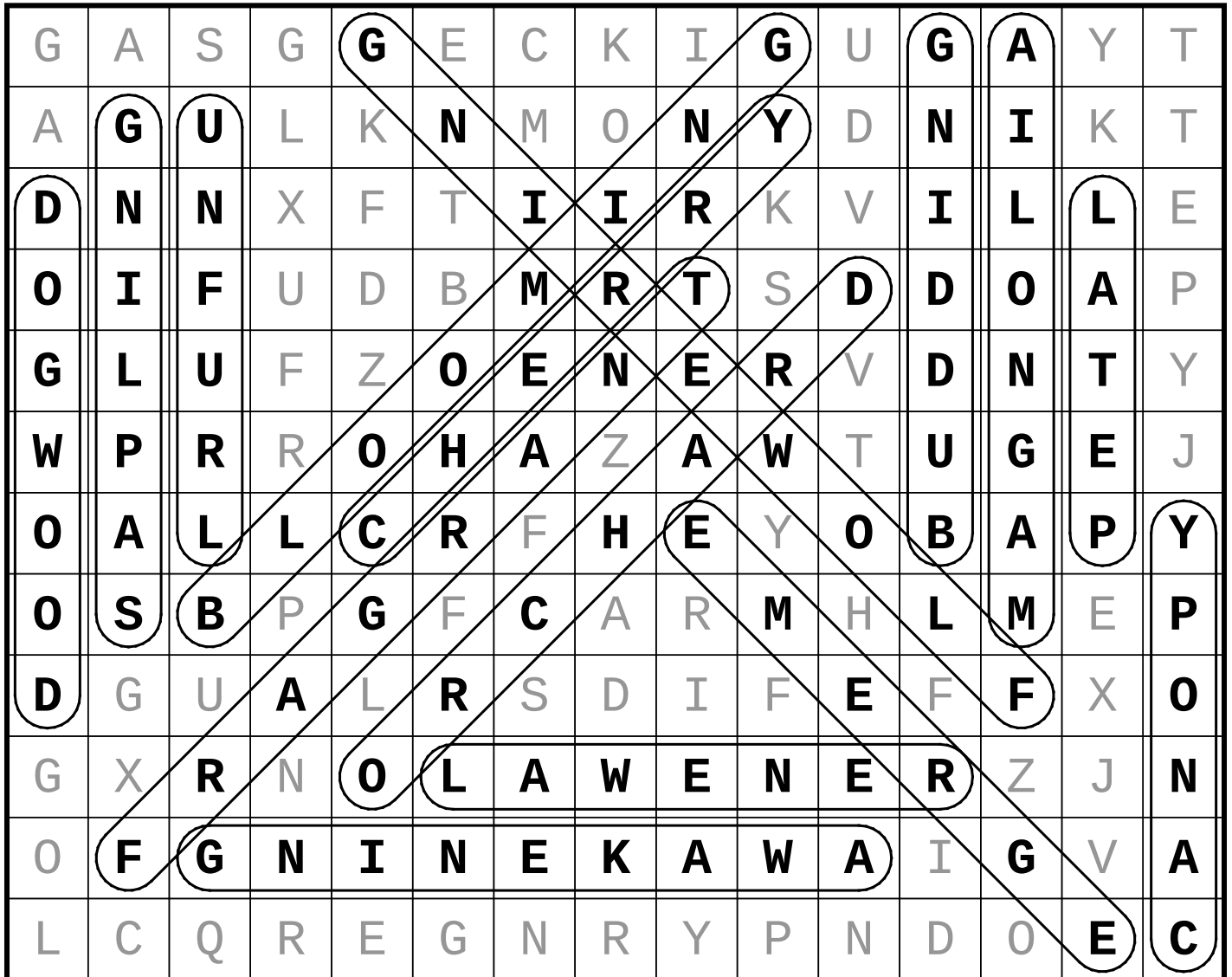

Did you know?

- Trees don't bud on a fixed calendar date; the specific trigger, called budburst, depends on accumulated warmth over time, not a single set temperature.
- Maple syrup is traditionally collected in very early spring specifically because that's when sap actively rises from the roots up through the tree.
- Cherry blossom viewing is a genuine, long-standing cultural tradition in Japan, known as hanami, drawing crowds specifically for the short blooming window.
- Not every tree blossoms in spring; some, like oaks, produce far less showy flowers that many people never really notice.

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
