- The "Ring of Fire," a horseshoe-shaped zone around the Pacific Ocean, is home to the majority of the world's active volcanoes.
- Not all volcanoes look like tall cone-shaped mountains; some are broad and gently sloped, built up from thin, fast-flowing lava.
- Mount Vesuvius, in Italy, is famous for its eruption in 79 AD that buried the Roman city of Pompeii.
- Some islands, including much of Hawaii and Iceland, were formed entirely by volcanic activity.

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
