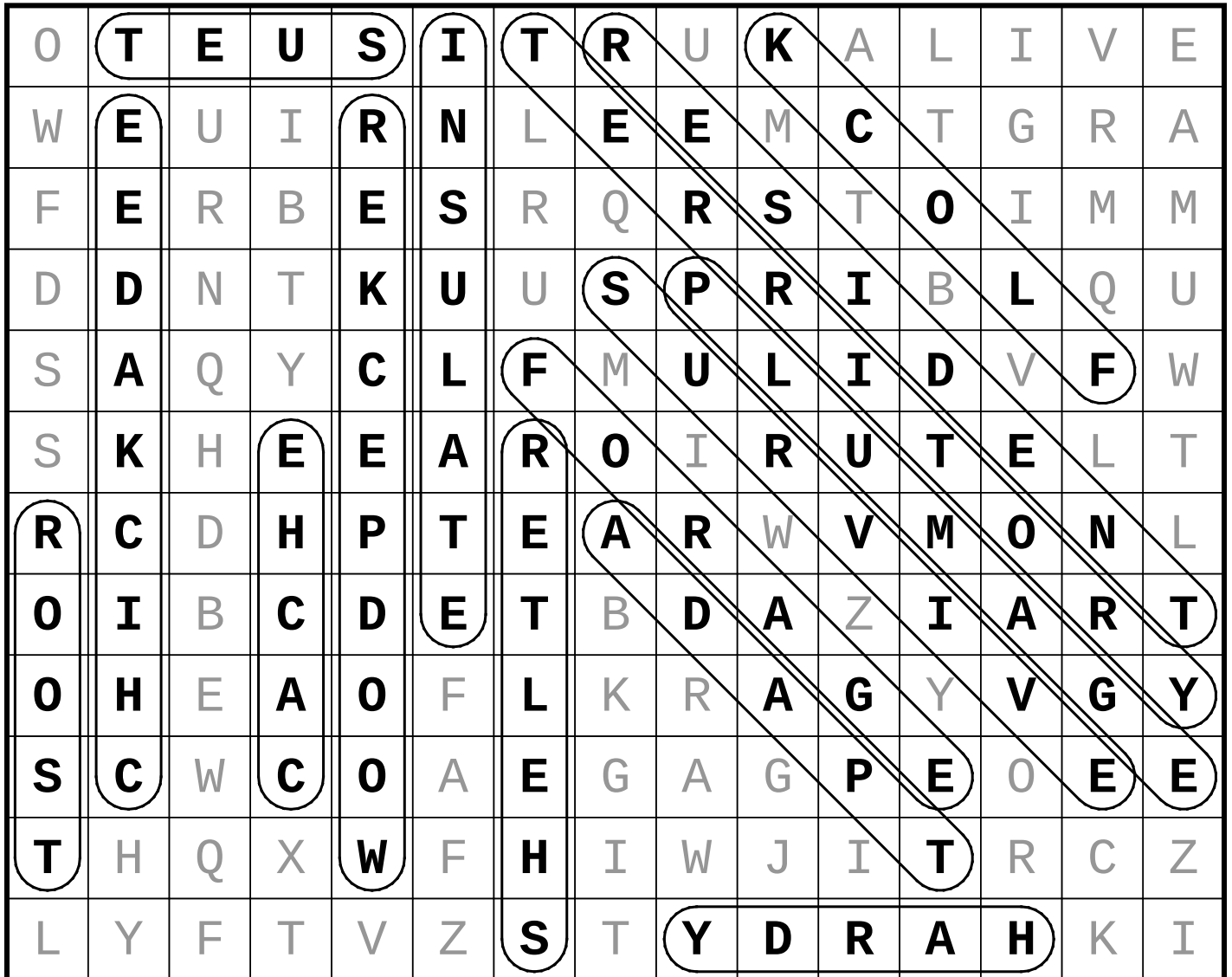

Winter Birds — Answer Key



Did you know?

- The ptarmigan, a bird found in cold northern regions, molts into white winter plumage, similar to how some mammals change coat color for camouflage.
- Some bird species that usually stay put will occasionally move south in large, unpredictable numbers during years when food is especially scarce, a phenomenon called an irruption.
- Backyard bird feeders commonly offer suet, a high-fat food block, specifically because many winter birds need extra calories to stay warm.
- Chickadees and some other small birds can lower their own body temperature slightly overnight to conserve energy during long, cold winter nights.

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
