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## Did you know?

- A blizzard is officially defined by specific wind speed, visibility and duration thresholds, not just heavy snowfall on its own.
- Windchill measures how cold moving air actually feels on exposed skin, since wind speeds up heat loss from the body beyond the plain air temperature.
- Freezing rain forms when raindrops fall through a layer of air below freezing near the ground, freezing on contact with cold surfaces.
- The term "polar vortex" describes a real, large-scale area of low pressure and cold air that normally circles the poles, which can occasionally dip farther south.

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
