Did you know?

- The Great Wall of China was built over many centuries, not as a single continuous project, by multiple different dynasties.
- The Eiffel Tower, built for a World's Fair in 1889, was originally intended as a temporary structure.
- Machu Picchu, an ancient Incan site in Peru, sits high in the Andes Mountains and was unknown to the wider world until the early 1900s.
- The Great Pyramid of Giza is the only surviving structure among the seven wonders of the ancient world.

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
